

Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

November 2016

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering November 6th to 12th, 2016, there were 567,800 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is a decrease of 1,400 from October 2016 and 10,000 less than the number employed in November 2015.

Agricultural employment was 38,600 persons in November 2016, down 600 from the October 2016 level and 3,200 less than the November 2015 agricultural employment level of 41,800. Non-agricultural employment was 529,200 persons in November 2016. This is a decrease of 800 from the October 2016 non-agriculture employment level of 530,000 and 6,800 less than November 2015.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for November 2016 was 6.4 percent. This is an increase of 0.3 percentage points from the October 2016 rate of 6.1 percent and 1.4 percentage points higher than the November 2015 level of 5.0 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force increased by 800 to 606,600 persons in November 2016 from 605,800 persons in October 2016. This is 1,700 less than the November 2015 labour force of 608,300 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate rose 0.1 percentage points to 69.6 percent in November 2016 from 69.5 percent in October 2016. The November 2015 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 70.4 percent.

There were 38,800 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during November 2016. This is an increase of 2,100 from October 2016 and is 8,300 more than the number unemployed in November 2015.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 569,300 persons employed in Saskatchewan in November 2016, up 2,400 from the October 2016 level of 566,900 and is down 9,800 from the November 2015 employment level of 579,100 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for November 2016 was 6.8 percent. This is a decrease of 0.1 percentage points from the October 2016 rate of 6.9 percent but 1.4 percentage points higher than the November 2015 rate of 5.4 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment decreased by 77,000 persons in November 2016 to 18,179,700 persons from 18,256,700 persons in October 2016. In November 2015, there were 17,993,200 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate remained unchanged in November 2016 from the October 2016 level of 6.3 percent. In November 2015, Canada's unemployment rate was 6.6 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 6.8 percent in November 2016. This is 0.2 percentage points lower than October 2016 and 0.2 percentage points lower than the November 2015 level of 7.0 percent.
