

# Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

September 2010

## UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey for the week ended September 18, 2010, there were 528,100 persons employed in Saskatchewan during September 2010, a decrease of 7,100 from August 2010 but 6,300 more than the number employed in September 2009.

Agricultural employment was 42,300 persons in September 2010, down 1,800 from the August 2010 level and 3,900 less than the September 2009 agricultural employment level of 46,200. Non-agricultural employment was 485,800 persons in September 2010. This is a decrease of 5,300 from the August 2010 non-agriculture employment level of 491,100 but 10,200 more than September 2009.

The Saskatchewan unemployment rate for September 2010 was 4.9 percent. This is a decrease of 0.8 percentage points from the August 2010 rate of 5.7 percent but 0.9 percentage points higher than the September 2009 level of 4.0 percent.

Saskatchewan's labour force decreased by 12,300 to 555,300 persons in September 2010 from 567,600 persons in August 2010. This is 11,800 more than the September 2009 labour force of 543,500 persons.

The Saskatchewan participation rate fell 1.6 percentage points to 69.9 percent in September 2010 from 71.5 percent in August 2010. The September 2009 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 69.5 percent.

There were 27,200 persons unemployed in Saskatchewan during September 2010. This is a decrease of 5,200 from August 2010 but is 5,500 more than the number unemployed in September 2009.

## SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a seasonally adjusted basis there were 526,800 persons employed in Saskatchewan in September 2010, down 4,600 from the August 2010 level of 531,400 but is up 7,000 from the September 2009 employment level of 519,800 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for September 2010 was 5.5 percent. This is an increase of 0.7 percentage points from the August 2010 rate of 4.8 percent and 0.8 percentage points higher than the September 2009 rate of 4.7 percent.

## CANADIAN DATA

Canadian employment decreased by 198,100 persons in September 2010 to 17,248,400 persons from 17,446,500 persons in August 2010. In September 2009, there were 16,901,300 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's unemployment rate decreased 1.3 percentage points to 7.4 percent from the August 2010 level of 8.7 percent. In September 2009, Canada's unemployment rate 7.6 percent.

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for Canada was 8.0 percent in September 2010. This is 0.1 percentage points lower than August 2010 and 0.3 percentage points lower than the September 2009 level of 8.3 percent.
