2016 Census of Canada

2016 CENSUS POPULATION

Saskatchewan's Census population for 2016 was 1,098,352, according to Statistics Canada. This represents an increase of 64,971 persons (6.3 percent) from the 2011 Census population of 1,033,381.

Table 1 shows the Census population counts and growth rates for Saskatchewan for the past 55 years.

CENSUS POPULATION BY TYPE OF COMMUNITY

All Saskatchewan cities (excluding the Saskatchewan part of Flin Flon) posted population gains in the 2016 Census. At the aggregate level, Saskatchewan cities grew 9.9 percent from 596,124 persons in 2011 to 655,313 persons in 2016. These people live in a total of 264,144 dwellings.

Town populations rose 2.7 percent (3,939 persons) from 145,778 persons in 2011 to 149,717 persons in 2016. These people live in a total of 63,371 dwellings.

Villages and Resort Villages accounted for 47,308 persons in 2016. This is an increase of 228 persons (0.5 percent) from the 2011 village and resort village population of 47,080. These people live in a total of 21,159 dwellings.

Indian Reserves also decreased in population between 2011 and 2016. Reserve population fell by 172 persons (0.3 percent) to 56,050 in 2016 from 56,222 in 2011. These people live in a total of 13,995 dwellings.

Rural Municipality population increased by 1,934 to 176,535 persons in 2016 from 174,601 persons in 2011. This represents an increase of 1.1 percent. These people live in a total of 65,770 dwellings.

Northern Villages, Hamlets, Crown Colonies, Unorganized and other populations fell 1,201 persons between 2011 and 2016 from 14,630 persons to 13,429 persons. These people live in a total of 4,183 dwellings.

All data in this report are based on the 2016 Census of Canada. The Census population counts are not comparable to quarterly population estimates from the Statistics Canada Demography Division. Census population does not include net undercount (number of persons missed by the Census less the number of persons counted twice) and other adjustments made by Demography Division to the Census data.
