MINISTER'S ORDERS

The Oil and Gas Conservation Act

DODSLAND VIKING SAND POOL — GOOD PRODUCTION PRACTICE

MRO 150/93. Pursuant to subsection 17(1) of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Act*, permission is granted to Westar Petroleum Ltd. to produce the vertical wells:

Westar Dodsland 9-16-31-22, GEOG Dodsland 10-16-31-22, Westar et al Dodsland 11-16-31-22, Westar et al Dodsland 14-16-31-22, Westar Dodsland 15-16-31-22, and Westar et al Dodsland 16-16-31-22,

according to good production practice for testing purposes subject to the following provisions:

1 This approval is for a term of one year expiring on March 31, 1994.

2 A progress report shall be submitted to the department upon conclusion of the test.

OTHER AREAS — WASTE WATER DISPOSAL

MRO 153/93. Pursuant to section 17.1 of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Act*, the application submitted by Canadian Crude Separators (Sask.) Inc. for disposing of waste water recovered from oilfield production by injection into the Mannville formation through the well located on legal subdivision 4 of Section 36-13-19 W3M, is approved in accordance with plans and specifications filed with the Saskatchewan Department of Energy and Mines as Document No. S.W.D. 375 and subject to the following provisions:

1 Installations shall be subject to the approval of a field representative of the Department prior to the commencement of waste water injection and subsequent to any modifications to such installations.

2 All injection volumes shall be metered with a Department approved method and reported to the Department on Form EM 219.

3 The wellhead injection pressure shall be limited to a maximum of 7 200 kilopascals.

4 No wastes that are generated outside the Province of Saskatchewan shall be disposed of into this well unless approval for such disposal is obtained from Saskatchewan Environment and Resource Management.

5 Waste waters which are not produced from a reservoir in association with oil or gas production of any type shall not be disposed of by injection into this well unless prior approval for such disposal is obtained from Saskatchewan Environment and Resource Management.

6 Saskatchewan Energy and Mines or Saskatchewan Environment and Resource Management may require that samples of waste to

be disposed of be taken from time to time and subjected to a complete chemical analysis.

7 For the detection of leaks, the volumes of waste water disposed of should be measured both by gauges at the tanks and by flow rate meters at the wellhead.

This approval does not authorize the applicant to dispose of waste water without the consent of all mineral owners, other than the Crown, that might reasonably be adversely affected by such disposal.

BROMHEAD MIDALE BEDS POOL — HORIZONTAL WELL PROJECT

MRO 154/93. The application submitted by Southward Energy Ltd. to conduct a horizontal well project in the Bromhead Midale Beds Pool is approved pursuant to section 17.1 of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Act*. Permission is granted to drill and complete one horizontal well in the Midale Beds underlying the north-east quarter of Section 24-3-13 W2M in accordance with plans and specifications filed with Saskatchewan Energy and Mines as Document No. H.W. 243 and subject to the following provisions:

1 The horizontal well shall not be subject to the provisions of MRO 40/68 PO 12.

2 The maximum allowable rate of production from the horizontal well shall be determined according to the provisions of MRO 260/91.

PIKES PEAK WASECA SAND POOL — STEAM INJECTION PROJECT EXPANSION

MRO 155/93. Permission is granted to construct the facilities and to drill and complete 12 wells on legal subdivisions 4 and 5 of Section 6-50-23 W3M, in accordance with plans and specifications filed with Saskatchewan Energy and Mines as Document No. P.M. 537 and subject to the conditions included in Minister's Approval MA 22/81, dated June 10, 1981.

EXTRACTS FROM THE RULES AND PROCEDURES OF THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF SASKATCHEWAN RELATING TO PRIVATE BILLS

PETITIONS

11.—(1) A petition to the Assembly may be presented by a Member at any time during the sitting of the Assembly by filing the same with the Clerk.

(6) Petitions may be either written or printed; provided always that when there are three or more petitioners, the signatures of at least three petitioners shall be subscribed on the sheet containing the prayer of the petition.

(9) No petition can be received which prays for any expenditure, grant or charge on the public revenue, whether payable out of the Consolidated Fund or out of moneys to be provided by the Assembly.

NOTE — A form of Petition can be obtained on application to the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly.

PRIVATE BILLS

59.—(1) All petitions for Private Bills shall be in duplicate and shall be filed with the Clerk of the Assembly not later than the twentieth sitting day of the Session.

(2) No petition for any Private Bill shall be received by the Assembly if presented after the first twenty-five sitting days of the Session.

(3) No Private Bill may be introduced in the Assembly after the first thirty sitting days of the Session.

60.—(1) Every applicant for a Private Bill shall deposit with the Clerk of the Assembly along with the Petition for same, two copies of the Bill, with marginal notes inserted, and an accepted cheque payable to the Minister of Finance for the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, if the said Bill does not exceed ten pages, and fifteen dollars additional for each page over that number; four hundred and fifty words shall be held to constitute a page.

(2) In the case of a bill incorporating a company a receipt from the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies for any statutory fees required shall also be deposited with the Clerk.

61. No remittance of a deposit on account of a Private Bill or any portion thereof shall be ordered by the Assembly unless the same has been recommended by the Committee charged with its consideration, or unless the Bill has been withdrawn, rejected or not reported upon, in which case the actual expenses incurred shall be deducted from the deposit received before making such remittance.

63.—(1) All petitions to the Legislature for Private Bills of any nature whatsoever, shall require a notice, clearly and distinctly specifying the nature and object of the application and where the same refers to any proposed work, and signed by and on behalf of the petitioners, with the address of the party signing the same; and when the petition is for an Act of Incorporation the name of the proposed company shall be stated in the notice.

(2) Such notice shall be published prior to the filing of the petition with the Clerk of the Assembly as required in Rule 59(1) in two consecutive issues of *The Saskatchewan Gazette* and four consecutive issues of a newspaper, published in English and having circulation in the locality affected.

(3) A copy of the notice with a statutory declaration of the several publications of advertisement shall be filed with the Clerk of the Assembly along with the petition and bill.

64.—(2) Every Bill for an Act of Incorporation, where a form of Model Bill has been adopted, shall be drawn in accordance with such Model Bill, copies of which may be obtained from the Clerk of the Assembly. Any provisions contained in any such Bill which are not in accord with the Model Bill shall be inserted between brackets and shall be so printed.

67. When any Bill for confirming any agreement is filed with the Clerk of the Assembly a true copy of such agreement must be attached to it.

COMMITTEE RULING

In cases where the proposed Bill provides that the property to be used or occupied by the petitioner be exempt from taxation, either in whole or in part, the petitioner must file with the Clerk of the

Assembly, along with the petition, a written statement from the local municipal authority in which the said property is situated approving the intent of the provisions of the proposed Bill which provide for the exemption from taxation.

The name of the Member who is to present the Petition and Private Bill must be furnished to the Clerk of the Assembly at the time of filing the Petition. Such member should not, of course, be a member of the Cabinet.
