[section 53]

RESTRUCTURING OF THE VILLAGE OF LESTOCK

Pursuant to section 53 of *The Municipalities Act*, the Village of Lestock has applied to restructure to become included in the Rural Municipality of Kellross No. 247 as a designated “Special Service Area”.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1 The Village of Lestock is restructured through the inclusion of the Village of Lestock within the Rural Municipality of Kellross No. 247.
- 2 The former Village of Lestock is designated as a “Special Service Area” for the purpose of assigning different tax rates, applying different tax tools and providing different service levels within the Rural Municipality of Kellross No. 247.

3 The boundaries of the former Village of Lestock designated as a Special Service Area are located in the Province of Saskatchewan, portions of Township 27, Range 14, Section 6 described as the north-west quarter and that portion of the north-east quarter lying west of the south-eastern boundary of public reserve R2 and Bimbo St. as shown on Plan Nos. 64H02567 and 59H07269 respectively and lying north of the north-eastern boundaries of the road shown on Plan No. 80H10388 and that portion of the south-west quarter of Section 7 lying west of the eastern boundary of Parcel C shown on Plan No. 75H09047 and lying south of the northern boundary of Parcel C, Block 1, 1st St. W, Block 3 and Parcel D shown on Plan Nos. 75H09047 and 77H00934; and portions of Township 27, Range 15 described as the most easterly 243.840 m in perpendicular width throughout of the Muskowekan Indian Reserve No. 85 lying between the north-eastern boundary of the road designated Parcel A on Plan No. 61H06146 and the south-western boundary of the Canadian National Railways Station Grounds shown on Plan No. AA3495. All West of the Second Meridian. The portions of sections described above include the adjoining south and west road allowances.

4 The Rural Municipality of Kellross No. 247 shall allocate all revenues collected from and on behalf of the Special Service Area to Special Service Area ledger accounts; and all expenses of the special service area shall be allocated to and paid from special service area ledger accounts.

5 A statement of revenues and expenditures of the special service area shall be presented to council annually and any additional time(s) requested by council.

6 The terms and conditions of the restructuring agreement entered into by the Village of Lestock and the Rural Municipality of Kellross No. 247 are confirmed as follows:

Opening Statement

(1) This agreement has been entered into by the Village of Lestock (the Village) and the Rural Municipality of Kellross No. 247 (the RM) for the purpose of the inclusion of the Village.

Restructuring Principles

(2) All parties agree to respectfully work together to negotiate sustainable, long-range mutual benefits to their citizens now and in the future.

(3) Where one municipality has concerns on a matter, all other municipalities will negotiate in good faith and work cooperatively toward a common goal and term of this agreement.

Governance

(4) A municipal council consisting of a reeve and seven councillors will govern the RM.

(5) Upon inclusion, the former Village shall be considered a separate division within the boundaries of the RM and as such a councillor shall be elected to represent that division.

(6) The municipal costs of the election for the division are a charge on the RM as a whole.

(7) All bylaws and resolutions in force in the Village continue in force for one year or until they are sooner repealed or others are made in their place.

Municipal Boundaries

(8) The RM consists of the land as described in Schedule A.

(9) Reference to any land described in Schedule A in any order, regulation, bylaw, resolution, and certificate of title, agreement or other instrument is deemed to be a reference to the RM.

Establishment of Special Service Area

(10) The former Village shall be designated a special service area for the purposes of assigning different tax rates and/or the application of tax tools and providing different service levels.

(11) The designated service area shall be within the boundaries of the former Village as described in Schedule B.

Disposition of Assets

(12) The assets and liabilities of the Village shall become assets and liabilities of the RM upon inclusion of the Village:

- (a) the RM will locate its office in the former Village of Lestock office, located at 215 Millersdale St.t;
- (b) the LED light stays operational.

(13) Cash assets remaining after settlement of the Village's assets and liabilities will be set aside for the provision of services and or benefits within the former Village.

(14) All grants received by the RM in recognition of the former Village will be set aside for provision of services and/or benefits within the former Village.

Integration of Administration

(15) The administrator of the Village will continue as an employee of the RM.

Service Delivery

General:

(16) All expenditures associated with service delivery within the special service area as set out below shall be allocated to the special service area accounts.

Employees:

(17) The RM will continue to employ Trevor Sugar, Bill Toth and Curtis Patenaude for the purpose of maintenance within the boundaries of the former Village consistent with current arrangements.

Fire Protection:

(18) The RM will ensure that fire protection services are inclusive and consistent with fire protection service agreements currently established by the Village.

Water and Sewer Utility:

(19) The RM will contract Brian Patterson as a Certified Water and Waste Water Operator consistent with current arrangements.

(20) That the sewer mains within the Special Service Area be flushed twice a year at minimum and expensed to the Special Service Area ledger accounts.

(21) The RM will maintain the waterworks system in the former Village and expensed to the Special Service Area ledger accounts.

Cemetery:

(22) The RM will assign the Administrator to administer the Lestock Cemetery; however, all physical maintenance and care applications shall be contracted out on an annual basis.

Landfill:

(23) The RM acknowledges that the Village holds Permit No. PO17-049 from the Ministry of Environment to operate the landfill until June 15, 2017. Therefore the landfill will be decommissioned pursuant to the Minister's Order. The RM will apply for grants including the Communities in Transition Grant to decommission the landfill.

Garbage:

(24) The RM shall retain the services of Lorass for the weekly collection of household garbage and monthly recycling for the residents of the Special Service Area consistent with current arrangements, plus have one large bin twice a year and expensed to the Special Service Area ledger accounts.

Street Maintenance/Snow Removal:

(25) The RM will provide street maintenance on roads consistent with current practices and may be modified as deemed necessary.

(26) The grounds and ditches (grass cutting and culverts) within the former Village will be maintained weekly during May to October.

(27) The RM designates Touchwood Hills Ave., Millersdale St. and Bimbo St. within the former Village as a school bus route during the winter months so that they are given priority for snow clearing due to the children taking the bus. Also the STARS Ambulance pad located west of Saint Joseph's Integrated Care Center and the Granitier St. to Saint Joseph's Integrated Care Centre to the Wishart grid road priority for snow clearing.

Recreation Facilities:

(28) The hall, park, ball diamonds, arena and playground shall continue to be managed by the RM Administrator and:

- (a) that the RM Council will consider the appointment of a Recreation Board;
- (b) all net proceeds from rentals and fundraising efforts from all Special Service Area recreational facilities will stay within the Special Service Area designated ledger revenue accounts;
- (c) Lestock Library will remain open at current location under the same operating conditions.

(29) The net proceeds from fundraising efforts from within the Special Service Area be set aside for the benefit of the Special Service Area (Recreation Board, etc.).

Amendments

(30) This agreement may be amended:

- (a) by the agreement of the councils which are signatories to the agreement, prior to the application being forwarded to the Minister for approval; and
- (b) by the RM after the Minister's Order, when an amendment after a period of two years is in the best interests of the ratepayers of the former Village and the RM.

Effective Date

(31) This agreement will come into effect on the date of restructuring as set out in the Minister's Order.

7 The restructuring will take effect on September 1, 2017.

8 The imposition of special levies is authorized on affected properties for a period not greater than 10 years or in the case of retiring a debt of the municipality not greater than the term of the debt, for the following purposes: renewing municipal infrastructure; remedying and reclaiming contaminated sites; and settling any liabilities.

9 Bev Gelech is appointed to adjust and settle the assets and liabilities of the Village of Lestock including:

- (a) the allocation of any grants, surplus funds and reserves; and
- (b) the manner of dealing with liabilities through:
 - (i) the sale of, the disposition of and conversion into money of sufficient assets to satisfy the liabilities of the Village and pay the remuneration of the person appointed by this Order; and
 - (ii) the ability to assess, levy, collect and enforce payment of any amount that may be required to satisfy the liabilities of the municipality, including all associated expenses and the remuneration of the person appointed by this Order, when the realizable assets do not satisfy the liabilities pursuant to 63(4) of *The Municipalities Act*.

10 Remuneration for settling the assets and liabilities be paid to Bev Gelech at a rate of \$30.00 per hour of work, in addition to 42.27 cents/travelled kilometre and reimbursement of related miscellaneous expenses.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

11 The "Special Service Area" formerly known as the Village of Lestock, is deemed to be within Division 5 in the Rural Municipality of Kellross No. 247, from the date of dissolution until an election for the new division is held; and the councillors of the Rural Municipality of Kellross No. 247 will be the interim council until the election is held on November 29, 2017.

12 A new division, namely Division 7, is created in the Rural Municipality of Kellross No. 247 effective November 29, 2017.

13 The boundaries of Division 7, being consistent with the boundaries of the former Village of Lestock, shall be described as follows:

Division 7:

Portions of Township 27, Range 14, Section 6, described as the north-west quarter and that portion of the north-east quarter lying west of the south-eastern boundary of public reserve R2 and Bimbo St. as shown on Plan Nos. 64H02567 and 59H07269 respectively and lying north of the north-eastern boundaries of the road shown on Plan No. 80H10388; and

Portion of Township 27, Range 14, Section 7, described as the south-west quarter lying west of the eastern boundary of Parcel C shown on Plan No. 75H09047 and lying south of the northern boundary of Parcel C, Block 1, 1st St. W, Block 3 and Parcel D shown on Plan Nos. 75H09047 and 77H00934; and

Portions of Township 27, Range 15, described as the most easterly 243.840 m in perpendicular width throughout of the Muskowekan Indian Reserve No. 85 lying between the north-eastern boundary of the road designated;

Parcel A on Plan No. 61H06146 and the south-western boundary of the Canadian National Railways Station Grounds shown on Plan No. AA3495;

All West of the Second Meridian in the Province of Saskatchewan;

The portions of sections described above include the adjoining south and west road allowances.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

14 An election be held on November 29, 2017, for a councillor to represent Division 7, as described herein to coincide with the effective date of the creation of the division.

15 Edith Goddard is appointed as Returning Officer, to conduct the election in accordance with *The Local Government Elections Act*.

16 The term of office for the councillor representing Division 7 shall begin November 29, 2017 and shall expire at the time of the general election October 2020, and every four years thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the area of the Rural Municipality of Kellross No. 247 shall be confirmed as follows:

Townships 25, 26 and 27 in Ranges 13, 14 and 15; and

Township 27A in Range 13A, 13, 14 and 15;

All West of the Second Meridian in the Province of Saskatchewan.

The seven divisions shall be confirmed as follows:

Division 1:

Townships 25 and 26, Range 13; All West of the Second Meridian.

Division 2

Township 25 and 26, Range 14; All West of the Second Meridian.

Division 3:

Township 25 and 26, Range 15; All West of the Second Meridian.

Division 4:

Township 27A, Range 13A, Townships 27 and 27A, Range 13; All West of the Second Meridian.

Division 5:

Township 27 and 27A, Range 14; All West of the Second Meridian.

Division 6:

Townships 27 and 27A, Range 15; All West of the Second Meridian.

Division 7:

Portions of Township 27, Range 14, Section 6, described as the north-west quarter and that portion of the north-east quarter lying west of the south-eastern boundary of public reserve R2 and Bimbo St. as shown on Plan Nos. 64H02567 and 59H07269 respectively and lying north of the north-eastern boundaries of the road shown on Plan No. 80H10388; and

Portion of Township 27, Range 14, Section 7, described as the south-west quarter lying west of the eastern boundary of Parcel C shown on Plan No. 75H09047 and lying south of the northern boundary of Parcel C, Block 1, 1st St. W, Block 3 and Parcel D shown on Plan Nos. 75H09047 and 77H00934; and

Portions of Township 27, Range 15, described as the most easterly 243.840 m in perpendicular width throughout of the Muskowekan Indian Reserve No. 85 lying between the north-eastern boundary of the road designated Parcel A on Plan No. 61H06146 and the south-western boundary of the Canadian National Railways Station Grounds shown on Plan No. AA3495;

Order No. 29/17. The SASKATCHEWAN MILK MARKETING BOARD, pursuant to the provisions of *The Milk Marketing Plan Regulations* and *The Agri-Food Act, 2004*, hereby determines and orders as follows:

- 1 Every licensed producer must achieve, retain, and maintain registration in ProAction.
- 2 If a licensed producer fails to comply with section 1, the Board shall provide the producer with a written notice within 10 days of such failure. The written notice will set out the dates on which price differential penalties (section 3) will apply.
- 3 The price differential penalties are applied on a rolling 12-month basis as follows:
 - (a) 2% below the blended price for one month of default;
 - (b) 4% below the blended price for the second month of default;
 - (c) 8% below the blended price for the third month of default;
 - (d) 16% below the blended price for the fourth month of default;
 - (e) 25% below the blended price for the fifth and any subsequent month(s) of default.
- 4 This Order will remain in effect for a period no longer than ten years from the date this Order is approved by the Agri-Food Council.
- 5 Order 23/16 is hereby wholly revoked.
