ORDERS IN COUNCIL

The Union Hospital Act

(O.C. 325/91)
16 April 1991

TO THE HONOURABLE
THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR IN
COUNCIL:

The undersigned has the honour to report that:

1 Subsection 7(1) of *The Union Hospital Act* provides that:

7(1) Where a portion of a union hospital district becomes organized as a municipality or becomes a part of a newly organized municipality . . . after the issue of the order defining the hospital district, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may

amend the order by redefining the district and providing for such other matters as are deemed to be necessary or expedient to take cognizance of such change.

2 By Your Honour's Order 458/89, the Moose Jaw Union Hospital District was defined as containing the Village of Spring Valley.

3 By Your Honour's Order 36/91, January 16, 1991, the Village of Spring Valley was dissolved and its area included within the R.M. of Terrell No. 101.

4 Therefore, it is desirable and in the public interest to redefine the Moose Jaw Union Hospital District to recognize this change.

The undersigned has the honour, therefore, to recommend that, pursuant to subsection 7(1) of *The Union Hospital Act*, Your Honour's Order do issue amending Your Honour's Order 458/89, to redefine the Moose Jaw Union Hospital District effective the date of this Order, to include the following municipalities and areas:

The Urban Municipality Act

(O.C. 479/91)
 28 May 1991

TO THE HONOURABLE

THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR IN
 COUNCIL:

The undersigned has the honour to report that:

1 Sections 13, 14 and 24 of *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984* provide, in part, that:

13(1) In this section, "council" means:

(a) the council of an urban municipality that intends to apply for an alteration of its boundaries . . . ; . . .

(7) The council may make an application for the alteration of its boundaries . . . in the form prescribed by the minister and shall submit:

(a) an application for the alteration of boundaries to:

(i) the minister, if all other municipalities affected by the proposed alteration provide the council with the complementary resolutions mentioned in clause (e); . . . ; . . .

together with:

(c) a map showing in detail the proposed alteration in boundaries . . . and a brief explanation of the reasons for the proposal;

(d) a certified copy of a resolution of the council requesting the proposed alteration . . . ;

(e) . . . a certified copy of a complementary resolution of the council of each municipality affected by the proposed alteration; . . . ; and

(g) a written summary of any public meeting held . . . and a copy of each written submission respecting the proposed alteration . . . received by the council . . .

(10) The minister may recommend to the Lieutenant Governor in Council that an application made pursuant to this section be approved, subject to any terms and conditions that the minister considers appropriate, or rejected.

14(1) On the recommendation of the minister pursuant to subsection 13(10) . . . the Lieutenant Governor in Council may, subject to any terms and conditions that he considers appropriate, by order:

(a) alter the boundaries of any urban municipality by:

(i) adding territory that shares a common boundary with the urban municipality to that urban municipality; . . .

(b) alter the boundaries of any other municipality affected by an order made pursuant to clause (a) so that they correspond to that order.

24 When making an order pursuant to this Part that results in the alteration of the boundaries of an urban municipality, the Lieutenant Governor in Council . . . shall:

(a) describe the actual alteration of the boundaries of the urban municipality; and

(b) describe the new boundaries of the urban municipality;

and, on and from the effective date of the order, all previous orders describing the boundaries of the urban municipality are repealed and the description of the boundaries in the most recent order is conclusively deemed to be the legal description of the boundaries of the urban municipality.

2 The council of the City of Regina has submitted an application for an alteration of its boundaries to the Minister of Community Services in the form prescribed by the Minister together with:

(a) a map showing in detail the proposed alteration in boundaries which involves adding territories to the City for future industrial development and to facilitate the operation and expansion of the landfill site;

(b) a certified copy of a resolution of the council of the City of Regina requesting the proposed alteration; and

(c) a certified copy of a complementary resolution of the council of the R.M. of Sherwood No. 159 affected by the proposed alteration.

3 A public meeting was not held as no written submissions respecting the proposed alteration were received by the council of the City.

The undersigned, therefore, has the honour to recommend that Your Honour's Order do issue pursuant to sections 13, 14 and 24 of *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984* subject to the following conditions:

(i) the City of Regina pays the R.M. of Sherwood No. 159 forthwith after the effective day of this Order a sum of 10 times the municipal tax levied on the properties being added to the City by this Order, payment to be based on the 1991 mill rate of 19 mills;

(ii) the City of Regina pays the R.M. of Sherwood No. 159 forthwith after the effective date of this Order a sum equal to the unpaid taxes to December 31, 1990 on all properties being added to the City by this Order and that the

1991 taxes shall be apportioned between the City and the R.M. on the basis of the number of months the properties are located in each municipality during 1991; and

(iii) the existing Regina Planning District Zoning Bylaw No. 3-83 of the R.M. of Sherwood No. 159 and Bylaw No. 7452 of the City of Regina remain in force for those territories being added to the City by this Order until repealed by the City pursuant to *The Planning and Development Act, 1983*:

(a) altering the boundaries of the City of Regina by adding to the City and withdrawing from the R.M. of Sherwood No. 159 territories adjoining the City and described in the attached "Schedule A";

(b) altering the boundaries of the R.M. of Sherwood No. 159 so that they correspond to this Order;

(c) confirming that the alteration shall take effect on the first day of the month following the date of this Order; and

(d) confirming that on and from the effective date of this Order the description of the boundaries of the City of Regina contained in all previous orders is repealed and the attached "Schedule B" is conclusively deemed to be the legal description of the boundaries of the City.

SCHEDULE A

The boundaries of the City of Regina are altered by adding to the City and withdrawing from the R.M. of Sherwood No. 159 the territories in Saskatchewan, in Canada lying:

in Township 18, in Range 19, West of the Second Meridian and described as:

(1) the west half of Section 3, excepting the road allowance intersection adjoining the south-west corner thereof;

(2) that portion of the east half of Section 4 lying south and east of the north-western boundary of the Canadian National Railways right-of-way shown on Plan No. CG4875, excepting the adjoining road allowance lying south thereof; and

(3) that portion of the south half of Section 5 lying north of a line drawn 483.230 m north of and parallel to the southern boundary of the said section, excepting:

(a) that part lying west of the eastern boundary of the Canadian Pacific Railway right-of-way shown on Plan No. AG5867; and

(b) that part lying east of the north-western boundary of the Canadian National Railways right-of-way shown on Plan No. CG4875.

SCHEDULE B

The boundaries of the City of Regina shall comprise the territory in Saskatchewan, in Canada lying:

in Township 17, in Range 19, West of the Second Meridian and described as:

(1) Section 5;

(c) that portion of the south-west quarter lying north of the northern boundary of the road shown on Plan No. FU741 and its production westerly;

(3) Section 7;

(4) Section 8, excepting the most easterly 20.117 m in perpendicular width throughout lying south of the most southerly north-eastern boundary of Parcel A shown on Plan No. BZ2842;

(5) that portion of Section 9 lying to the right of the centre line of the Wascana Creek;

(6) Sections 10 and 15 to 21 inclusive;

(7) Section 22, including that part of the road allowance adjoining the eastern boundary thereof lying north of a line joining the south-east corner of Buffer Strip PB1 shown on Plan No. 84R59480 and the north-west corner of road Parcel Y in the north-west quarter of Section 23 shown on Plan No. 61R28144;

(8) that portion of Section 27 lying south of the south-eastern boundary of the Canadian Pacific Railway main line right-of-way shown on Plan No. 16074, including:

(a) the road allowance adjoining the eastern boundary thereof lying south of a line drawn parallel with and 30.480 m south-easterly from the centre line of the said Canadian Pacific Railway main line right-of-way; and

(b) the road allowance intersection adjoining the south-east corner of Section 27;

(9) Section 28, including that part of the road allowance adjoining the eastern boundary thereof lying north of the south-eastern boundary of the Canadian Pacific Railway main line right-of-way shown on Plan No. 16074;

(10) Section 29 to 32 inclusive; and

(11) Section 33, including the adjoining road allowance lying east thereof.

in Township 18, in Range 19, West of the Second Meridian and described as:

(1) the west half of Section 3;

(2) the following portions of Section 4:

(a) that portion lying south and east of the north-western boundary of the Canadian National Railways right-of-way shown on Plan No. CG4875; and

(b) that portion lying between the north-western boundary of the said Canadian National Railways right-of-way, and the south-western boundary of the road shown on Plan No. FF2360;

(3) the following portions of Section 5:

(a) the south half; and

(b) that portion of the north-west quarter lying west of the eastern boundary of the Canadian Pacific Railway right-of-way shown on Plan No. AG5867;

(4) Section 6, including that part of the road allowance adjoining the eastern boundary thereof lying north of the intersection of the eastern boundary of the Canadian Pacific Railway right-of-way shown on Plan No. AG5867 with the western boundary of Section 5; and

(5) that portion of the south half of Section 7 lying east of the eastern and north-eastern boundaries of the road shown on Plan No. 60R19475, including the adjoining road allowance lying east thereof.

in Township 17, in Range 20, West of the Second Meridian and described as:

(1) that portion of Section 1 lying north of the northern boundary of the road shown on Plans No. 66R28109, FU1798 and 59R24336 and its production easterly;

(2) that portion of the east half of Section 2 lying east of the western boundary of the abandoned Canadian National Railways right-of-way shown on Plan No. CT2865 and lying north of the northern boundary of the road shown on Plan No. 66R28109 and its production westerly;

(3) Sections 11 to 15 and 22 to 27 inclusive;

(4) that portion of the south-east quarter of Section 28 lying east of the western boundary of Parcels A and B shown on Plans No. FR906 and 91R13008 respectively;

(5) Section 33, including:

(a) the adjoining road allowance lying north of the north-west quarter; and

(b) the road allowance intersection adjoining the north-west corner of Section 33; and

(6) Sections 34 to 36 inclusive.

Unless otherwise specified, the Sections and portions of Sections described in the above schedules include the adjoining south and west road allowances, intersections thereof and widenings thereto by plan of survey.

The right and left bank of the Wascana Creek is determined by facing downstream at a point mid-stream.

**EXTRACTS FROM THE RULES AND
PROCEDURES OF THE
LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF
SASKATCHEWAN RELATING TO
PRIVATE BILLS**

PETITIONS

11.—(1) A petition to the Assembly may be presented by a Member at any time during the sitting of the Assembly by filing the same with the Clerk.

(6) Petitions may be either written or printed; provided always that when there are three or more petitioners, the signatures of at least three petitioners shall be subscribed on the sheet containing the prayer of the petition.

(9) No petition can be received which prays for any expenditure, grant or charge on the public revenue, whether payable out of the Consolidated Fund or out of moneys to be provided by the Assembly.

NOTE — A form of Petition can be obtained on application to the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly.

PRIVATE BILLS

56.—(1) All petitions for Private Bills shall be in duplicate and shall be filed with the Clerk of the Assembly not later than the twentieth sitting day of the Session.

(2) No petition for any Private Bill shall be received by the Assembly if presented after the first twenty-five sitting days of the Session.

(3) No Private Bill may be introduced in the Assembly after the first thirty sitting days of the Session.

57.—(1) Every applicant for a Private Bill shall deposit with the Clerk of the Assembly along with the Petition for same, two copies of the Bill, with marginal notes inserted, and an accepted cheque payable to the Minister of Finance for the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, if the said Bill does not exceed ten pages, and fifteen dollars additional for each page over that number; four hundred and fifty words shall be held to constitute a page.

(2) In the case of a bill incorporating a company a receipt from the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies for any statutory fees required shall also be deposited with the Clerk.

58. No remittance of a deposit on account of a Private Bill or any portion thereof shall be ordered by the Assembly unless the same has been recommended by the Committee charged with its consideration, or unless the Bill has been withdrawn, rejected or not reported upon, in which case the actual expenses incurred shall be deducted from the deposit received before making such remittance.

60.—(1) All petitions to the Legislature for Private Bills of any nature whatsoever, shall require a notice, clearly and distinctly specifying the nature and object of the application and where the same refers to any proposed work, indicating generally the location of the work, and signed by and on behalf of the petitioners, with the address of the party signing the same; and when the

petition is for an Act of Incorporation the name of the proposed company shall be stated in the notice.

(2) Such notice shall be published prior to the filing of the petition with the Clerk of the Assembly as required in Rule 56(1) in two consecutive issues of *The Saskatchewan Gazette* and four consecutive issues of a newspaper, published in English and having circulation in the locality affected.

(3) A copy of the notice with a statutory declaration of the several publications of advertisement shall be filed with the Clerk of the Assembly along with the petition and bill.

61.—(2) Every Bill for an Act of Incorporation, where a form of Model Bill has been adopted, shall be drawn in accordance with such Model Bill, copies of which may be obtained from the Clerk of the Assembly. Any provisions contained in any such Bill which are not in accord with the Model Bill shall be inserted between brackets and shall be so printed.

64. When any Bill for confirming any agreement is filed with the Clerk of the Assembly a true copy of such agreement must be attached to it.

COMMITTEE RULING

In cases where the proposed Bill provides that the property to be used or occupied by the petitioner be exempt from taxation, either in whole or in part, the petitioner must file with the Clerk of the Assembly, along with the petition, a written statement from the local municipal authority in which the said property is situated approving the intent of the provisions of the proposed Bill which provide for the exemption from taxation.

The name of the Member who is to present the Petition and Private Bill must be furnished to the Clerk of the Assembly at the time of filing the Petition. Such member should not, of course, be a member of the Cabinet.
