SASKATCHEWAN REGULATIONS 30/2018

The Health Administration Act

Section 17

Order in Council 226/2018, dated May 3, 2018

(Filed May 3, 2018)

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Health Professions Training Bursary Amendment Regulations, 2018*.

RRS c D-17 Reg 10, section 3 amended

2 Subsection 3(1) of *The Health Professions Training Bursary Regulations* is amended by striking out “for a maximum period of four years”.

Coming into force

3 These regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations.

SASKATCHEWAN REGULATIONS 31/2018*The Saskatchewan Assistance Act*

Section 14

Order in Council 227/2018, dated May 3, 2018

(Filed May 3, 2018)

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Saskatchewan Assured Income for Disability (Exemptions) Amendment Regulations, 2018*.

RRS c S-8 Reg 11 amended

2 *The Saskatchewan Assured Income for Disability Regulations, 2012* are amended in the manner set forth in these regulations.

Section 8 amended

3(1) Subsection 8(1) is amended:

- (a) by adding “or” after clause (c);
- (b) by striking out “or” after clause (d); and
- (c) by repealing clause (e).

(2) The following subsections are added after subsection 8(1):

“(1.1) Notwithstanding sections 6 and 7 but subject to subsection (1.2), no benefit is to be paid to or on behalf of an individual or family unit if the individual or any family member receives a monthly pension pursuant to Part 1 of the *Old Age Security Act* (Canada).

“(1.2) Subsection (1.1) does not apply if, before September 1, 2017, the individual or family member commenced receiving, and continues to receive, both of the following:

- (a) a benefit pursuant to these regulations;
- (b) a monthly pension pursuant to Part 1 of the *Old Age Security Act* (Canada)”.

Appendix amended

4 The following clauses are added after clause (2)(tt) of Table 1 of the Appendix:

“(uu) a payment of compensation to the individual that is related to a claim for the loss of culture and identity with respect to the practice of removing Aboriginal children from their families and placing them for adoption in non-Aboriginal homes, commonly known as the Sixties Scoop;

“(vv) a payment of compensation to a class member pursuant to a plan approved by the Ontario Superior Court of Justice in the matter of *Parsons v Canadian Red Cross Society*, decided on October 22, 1999 (Court file numbers 98-CV-141369 and 98-CV-146405), not including any payments for lost income or loss of support”.

RRS c S-8 Reg 12, Appendix amended

2 **Table 1 of the Appendix of *The Saskatchewan Assistance Regulations, 2014* is amended by adding the following clauses after clause (2)(uu):**

“(vv) a payment of compensation to the individual that is related to a claim for the loss of culture and identity with respect to the practice of removing Aboriginal children from their families and placing them for adoption in non-Aboriginal homes, commonly known as the Sixties Scoop;

“(ww) a payment of compensation to a class member pursuant to a plan approved by the Ontario Superior Court of Justice in the matter of *Parsons v Canadian Red Cross Society*, decided on October 22, 1999 (Court file numbers 98-CV-141369 and 98-CV-146405), not including any payments for lost income or loss of support”.

Section 14

Order in Council 229/2018, dated May 3, 2018

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Transitional Employment Allowance (Exemptions) Amendment Regulations, 2018*.

RRS c S-8 Reg 6, section 8 amended

2 *The Transitional Employment Allowance Regulations, 2005* are amended by adding the following clauses after clause 8(2)(o):

“(p) a payment of compensation to the individual that is related to a claim for the loss of culture and identity with respect to the practice of removing Aboriginal children from their families and placing them for adoption in non-Aboriginal homes, commonly known as the Sixties Scoop;

“(q) a payment of compensation to a class member pursuant to a plan approved by the Ontario Superior Court of Justice in the matter of *Parsons v Canadian Red Cross Society*, decided on October 22, 1999 (Court file numbers 98-CV-141369 and 98-CV-146405), not including any payments for lost income or loss of support”.

Coming into force

3 These regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations.
