


## Industry Tip

### Time-out Fix for Physical Geological Inventory Data Extract

Date	Module/Application/Functionality	Notes
June 6, 2018	Infrastructure/Geology Inventory/Basic Search	Timeout Fix

The IRIS 5.14 release will allow for the export of core, drill cuttings or thin section data for the entire province without timing-out. This task can be performed in IRIS under the Infrastructure/Geology Inventory/Basic Search functionality with: Extract Data set to “Yes”; Search for set to either “Core Interval”, “Drill Cutting” or “Thin Section”; Well Licence Date Range set as 1900-01-01 to current date, and; the From Land Location (SE) and To Land Location (NW) left blank.
