



Jury Findings

THIS IS AN EXTRACT OF THE JURY REPORT FILED AT THE INQUEST RESPECTING THE DEATH OF WALTER CLINTON MCKENZIE WHICH WAS CONDUCTED MARCH 3 - 6, 2014 AT LA RONGE, SASKATCHEWAN

The 6 person jury inquired into the death of the above named and their findings are as follows:

Name of Deceased: Walter Clinton McKenzie
Date of Death: September 8, 2010 at 02:55 hours
Place of Death: Royal University Hospital, Saskatoon, SK
Cause of Death: Blunt Force Trauma resulting in subdural hemorrhage
By What Means: Accidental

Recommendations:

1. To the Town of La Ronge and Mamawetan Church hill river health region:

We recommend the development of an Overnight shelter for homeless and or alcoholic individuals, who can be supervised under basic medical personnel. To include an outreach program to educate on consequences and places of assistance for those in need.

2. To the La Ronge Health Centre:

We recommend medical equipment upgrades, such as, a handheld CT scanner to adequately assess potential neurological cases.

3. To the RCMP La Ronge detachment:

We recommend mandatory adherence to policy for guards surrounding using both video AND physical “through the window” observations of prisoners. Mandatory adherence to policy for members of the RCMP surrounding rousability of prisoners.
