REVISED REGULATIONS OF SASKATCHEWAN

SASKATCHEWAN REGULATIONS 119/2003

The Milk Control Act, 1992

Section 10

Board Order, dated October 21, 2003

(Filed October 22, 2003)

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Milk Control Amendment Regulations, 2003 (No. 10)*.

R.R.S. c.M-15 Reg 1, Appendix amended

2(1) Part II of the Appendix to *The Milk Control Regulations* is amended in the manner set out in this section.

(2) Section 2 is amended:

(a) in clause (c) by striking out “concentrated liquid milk” and substituting “condensed milk to be reconstituted as fluid milk”; and

(b) in clause (g) by striking out “and butteroil” and substituting “, butteroil and any other milk products not mentioned in this section except new products mentioned in paragraph (j)(i)(B)”.

(3) Subsection 3(1) is amended:

(a) in subclause (a)(i) by striking out “\$51.05” and substituting “\$48.20”;

(b) in subclause (b)(i) by striking out “\$51.05” and substituting “\$48.20”;

(c) in subclause (c)(i) by striking out “\$51.05” and substituting “\$48.20”; and

(d) by repealing clauses (m) and (n) and substituting the following:

“(m) in the case of class 5a milk:

(i) \$3.6719 per kilogram of butterfat;

(ii) \$9.4232 per kilogram of protein; and

(iii) \$0.0527 per kilogram of other solids;

“(n) in the case of class 5b milk:

(i) \$3.6719 per kilogram of butterfat;

(ii) \$1.9967 per kilogram of protein; and

(iii) \$1.9967 per kilogram of other solids”.

Coming into force

3 These regulations come into force on November 1, 2003.

SASKATCHEWAN REGULATIONS 120/2003*The Saskatchewan Medical Care Insurance Act*

Sections 14 and 48

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Saskatchewan Medical Care Insurance Payment Amendment Regulations, 2003 (No.5)*.

R.R.S. c.S-29 Reg 19, section 3 amended

2 Clause 3(b) of *The Saskatchewan Medical Care Insurance Payment Regulations, 1994* is amended:

- (a) by striking out “and” after subclause (ii);
- (b) in subclause (iii) by adding “and ending on March 31, 2003” after “commencing on January 1, 2003”; and
- (c) by adding the following after subclause (iii):
 - “(iv) for services provided in the period commencing on April 1, 2003 and ending on March 31, 2004, the schedule adopted by the department for payment of dentist services and entitled ‘Saskatchewan Health Payment Schedule for Insured Services Provided by a Dentist, April 1, 2003’; and
 - “(v) for services provided in the period commencing on April 1, 2004, the schedule adopted by the department for payment of dentist services and entitled ‘Saskatchewan Health Payment Schedule for Insured Services Provided by a Dentist, April 1, 2004’”.

Coming into force

3 These regulations come into force on the day on which they are filed with the Registrar of Regulations, but are retroactive and are deemed to have been in force on and from April 1, 2003.
