MINISTERIAL APPROVAL OF A PRODUCT STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM

TIRE STEWARDSHIP OF SASKATCHEWAN INC.

WHEREAS:


- A. Tires are prescribed products for the purposes of clause 46(a) of *The Environmental Management and Protection Act, 2010*.
- B. Pursuant to *The Scrap Tire Management Regulations* (the Regulations), no first seller shall fail to operate a Product Stewardship Program approved by the Minister of Environment; or enter into an agreement with a person to operate, on the first seller's behalf, a Product Stewardship Program approved by the Minister.

MINISTERIAL APPROVAL is hereby given to Tire Stewardship of Saskatchewan Inc. of Regina, Saskatchewan, hereinafter called the Applicant, to operate a Product Stewardship Program in the Province of Saskatchewan in accordance with the following conditions: for the proposed change subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The Applicant shall operate the PMP in accordance with the proposal dated September 28, 2017, titled Proposed Product Stewardship Program for Scrap Tire Management: 2018-2020.
- 2. The Applicant shall advise the Minister of Environment (the Minister) of any change in design of the Product Management Program from the proposal upon which the approval is granted and shall obtain prior approval for any such change.
- 3. The Applicant shall ensure the program is launched on or before January 1, 2018, as described in Section 1 of the approved PSP.
- 4. Under the conditions set forth in Section 9 of the Regulations, this approval may be cancelled at any time by the Minister of Environment if it is determined that the conditions of the Approval not been properly followed.
- 5. The Applicant must develop a compliance plan and procedure jointly with the Ministry of Environment. The plan shall be in place within six months of launching the program in January 2018.
- 6. The Applicant shall submit their first annual report as outlined in the Regulations on or before June 30, 2018, describing the activities of the PSP as stated in Section 12 of the Regulations.
- 7. This Approval takes effect on the date of signing.
