Liability Waiver

Please read and acknowledge the following terms.

I, for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, waive any and all claims to which I may become entitled to for injury or damage and release the Minister of Parks, Culture and Sport and the Government of Saskatchewan, its agents and employees from any and all claims for damages, loss, expense or injury (including death) suffered by me or that my next of kin may suffer, as a result of my use of Camp-Easy: Equipped Camping equipment (including, but not limited to, camp stove, propane tank, fire pit and axe), due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence, breach of contract, or breach of any statutory duty of care.

I further state I recognize it is dangerous to use a camp stove inside a tent or shelter, that propane is highly flammable and should be kept far away from any heat source or open flame. I declare that I will take appropriate precautions when chopping wood, including wearing long pants and closed toe shoes/boots and staying far away from other people when swinging an axe. I am aware that use or operation of camping equipment may result in physical injury or death and voluntarily assume all risks associated with its use.

I further understand Camp-Easy permit holders are responsible for the conduct and behavior of their family and guests and shall assure permit conditions and regulations are being met.
