1 Section 3 of *The Forest Resources Management Regulations* provides, in part, as follows:

3(2) The minister may withdraw land from a provincial forest with the written approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

(3) Where land is withdrawn from a provincial forest by the minister:

(a) the written approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council and the reasons for withdrawing the land are to be published in the Gazette; and

ORDER FOR ROAD RESTRICTIONS ON PROVINCIAL HIGHWAY 40-03-10

Pursuant to section 35 of *The Highway and Transportation Act, 1997*;

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that effective Midnight, March 1, 2004, and until further notice, vehicles other than those exempted below and those vehicles described in subsections 3(1) and (2) of the *The Vehicle Weight and Dimensions Regulations, 1999*, on the following provincial highways:

Provincial Highway 40-03-10 (commonly known as the David Laird Campsite Road) from the Junction of Highway 40 to the Junction of Highway 16 (1.29 km) except for:

(i) when directly crossing Provincial Highway 40-03-10 at an intersecting public highway;

shall be restricted as follows:

- the maximum gross vehicle weight not to exceed 8 000 kg (17,600 lbs.);
- the maximum gross weight on any axle unit not to exceed 6 000 kg (13,200 lbs.);

the restriction applies to all vehicles except those listed below:

- emergency vehicles;
- Department of Highways and Transportation vehicles when conducting maintenance or accessing sites on or along the restricted highway;

- SaskPower vehicles when accessing sites along the restricted route;
- recreational vehicles;
- buses; or
- farm equipment.

This order does not permit the weight on any axle, axle group or vehicle from exceeding the secondary weight prescribed in the *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations, 1999* for that axle, axle group or vehicle.

This Order is issued on a permanent basis and should not be confused with Spring Road Restriction Orders.

Pursuant to section 17 of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Act*, MRO 815/03 PO 45, dated September 8, 2003, is rescinded and the provisions in the following schedule shall apply to the drilling of and production from gas wells in the "Hatton Milk River Gas Pool", effective January 1, 2004.

Dated at Regina, Saskatchewan, January 8, 2004.

Schedule

1 The drainage unit for the drilling and completion of a gas well shall be four legal subdivisions in a Section, grouped as follows:

legal subdivisions 1, 2, 7 and 8; 3, 4, 5 and 6; 9, 10, 15 and 16; 11, 12, 13 and 14;

with the exception of the following drainage units which shall be:

(a) the fractional quarter Section containing approximately 40 hectares within the area described in clause 2(a);

(b) the fractional north half or fractional south half of the Section containing approximately 70 hectares within the area described in clauses 2(b), (f) and (i);

(c) for the area described in clause 2(g), the drainage unit shall be comprised of two legal subdivisions in a Section, grouped as follows:

legal subdivisions 1 and 2; 3 and 4; 5 and 6; 7 and 8; 9 and 10; 11 and 12; 13 and 14; 15 and 16.

2 Within a drainage unit, the sides of the target area shall be 200 m from the sides of the drainage unit, with the exception of the following areas located West of Third Meridian:

(a) in Townships 12 to 14, Range 30: Legal subdivisions 3 to 6 and 11 to 14 of Sections 2, 11, 14, 23, 26 and 35:

(i) the east and west sides of the target area shall be located 150 m from the corresponding sides of the drainage unit;

(ii) the north and south sides of the target area shall be located 200 m from the corresponding sides of the drainage unit;

- (b) in Township 17, Range 30: fractional Sections 24, 25 and 36;

3 All gas wells drilled to or completed in this pool prior to July 1, 1994, shall be considered to be drilled on-target as prescribed in section 2.

4 Unless otherwise ordered by the minister, wells producing from the Hatton Milk River Gas Pool shall not be subject to a production allowable.

5 Unless otherwise ordered by the minister, every well shall be flow tested within three months after commencement of production in a manner approved by the minister and any such flow tests may be made in lieu of subsections 73(1) and (2) of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Regulations, 1985*.

6 The operator shall run the following logs as a minimum requirement for gas wells drilled in this pool:

- (a) for at least one well per Section, an approved resistivity log or standard electric log shall be run;
- (b) an approved pulsed neutron capture log may be substituted for the requirements of clause (a);
- (c) the remaining wells in a Section shall be logged with an approved radioactivity log, consisting of both natural and induced radioactivity measurements, or in accordance with clauses (a) or (b);
- (d) all logs shall be run over the interval from surface casing shoe to total depth.

7 For exploratory drilling, the target area for gas wells to be drilled for zones other than the Milk River formation and the Medicine Hat Sand may be as described in this order, but only one such well shall be allowed to produce in each Section in the following area located West of the Third Meridian:

- in Township 15, Range 28: Sections 25 to 28 and 32 to 36;
- in Township 16, Ranges 26 to 28: all Sections;
- in Township 16, Range 29: Sections 1 to 5, 8 to 16, 21 to 26 and 33 to 36;
- in Township 17, Ranges 26 to 29: all Sections;
- in Township 18, Ranges 28 and 29: all Sections.

MRO 05/04 PO 97. Pursuant to section 17 of *The Oil and Gas Conservation Act*, MRO 566/03 PO 33, dated June 23, 2003, is rescinded and the following provisions shall apply to the drilling of, and production from, gas wells in the Abbey North Milk River Gas Pool, effective January 1, 2004:

1 The drainage unit for the drilling and completion of a gas well shall be the north half or the south half of a Section, with the exception of the area described in clause 2(b), where the drainage unit shall be the east half of a Section or the west half of a Section and the area described in 2(c), where the drainage unit shall be the north-east, north-west, south-east or south-west quarter of a Section.
