Greg was appointed Deputy Minister of Government Relations and Deputy Minister of First Nation, Métis and Northern Affairs on August 22, 2018. Government Relations employs about 280 staff in three divisions: Corporate Services and Disaster Recovery, First Nations, Métis and Northern Affairs, and Municipal Relations.

Greg's previous work with the Saskatchewan public service includes the role of Deputy Minister of Social Service. Under his leadership, the province launched the Saskatchewan Poverty Reduction Strategy in February 2016. The ministry also announced improved access to birth registration information for adoptees and birth parents, and became the first province in Canada to provide training for foster families online. Also in 2016, the Ministry announced plans to redesign its suite of income assistance programs, the most significant work to be done in this area in more than 50 years.



Prior to joining Social Services, Greg was Associate Deputy Minister for Saskatchewan Education. He led the Ministry in the areas of Pre-Kindergarten to Grade 12 education, and was responsible for guiding the work of Student Achievement and Supports, Early Learning, and the Provincial Library and Literacy Office.

Greg was born the 22nd child in a family of 24 siblings. His firsthand experiences with the human service systems continue to fuel his passion for the work he does today.
