David Button

David Button (Dave) was appointed Vice-President (Administration) July 1, 2006. As Vice-President, Button is responsible for the basic logistics of running the University. The portfolio includes leadership responsibilities for Human Resources, Financial Services, Facilities Management, Information Services and Ancillary Services.

University support requires operations and services equivalent to that of a small city. The 15,000 students, 2,000 of which are international, are served by 2,400 employees of which 450 are faculty and 1,250 are full-time or term staff. The overall operating budget of the University is approximately \$210 million dollars. The Vision of the Office of the Vice-President is to make the University of Regina a preferred place to Live, Work and Study.

Immediately prior to this appointment, Button served for 11 years as the Associate Vice-President (Facilities and Planning) at the University of Regina. He also teaches extensively in the area of Project Management as an Adjunct in the faculties of Graduate Studies, Engineering, and Business.

Button was born in Middleton, Nova Scotia and has lived and worked in virtually every province in Canada, as well as a number of places in Europe. He has a degree in Civil Engineering from the Royal Military College in Kingston, and postgraduate degrees from the University of British Columbia (Planning) and the Canadian Forces Command and Staff College (pcsc). He is a Chartered Director, Professional Engineer, Certified Educational Facilities Professional, Project Management Professional, and Planner.
