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SASKATCHEWAN REAL ESTATE COMMISSION — REGULATORY BYLAW AMENDMENTS

**Bylaw 625 is to be repealed, and replaced with the following new Bylaw 625:**

**“625(1)** Where the Act, the regulations or the bylaws require an agreement to include a written signature, the signature requirement will be satisfied by:

- (a) an electronic signature that:
  - (i) is originally created by the signatory by way of:
    - (A) a handwritten signature;

- (B) a keyboard allowing the signatory to enter in their name as their signature; or
  - (C) drawing their signature and initials in a custom fashion utilizing a mouse, stylus or their finger depending upon the device being used to access the signing;
  - (ii) is digitized and embedded permanently in the document to which it pertains; and
  - (iii) has attached to the document, a record from the electronic signature software or application provider which certifies when, where, and by whom the document was executed.
- (2) Where the Act, the regulations or the bylaws require an agreement to be executed and/or signed in writing in the presence of a witness, this requirement will be satisfied by:
- (a) an electronic signature meeting the requirements set out in subsection (1) above;
  - (b) the consent to execute documents by way of electronic signature has been established by the registrant representing the purchaser or the seller (each of which is referred to as a “signatory”) at the time the registrant is retained by the purchaser or the seller; and
  - (c) the registrant utilizes software which:
    - (i) accurately reflects the information set forth in the contract;
    - (ii) is capable of providing detailed transaction logs accessible to the registrant and which allows each signing participant the ability to review signing progress/history for the document in question;
    - (iii) ensures the security of the signed document such that once signed by a signatory, the content of that document cannot be altered; and
    - (iv) ensures that once signed by a signatory, that signature cannot be moved or removed from where it was affixed by the signatory”.

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**RULES OF COURT/RÈGLES DE PROCÉDURE**  
COURT OF APPEAL FOR SASKATCHEWAN/COUR D'APPEL DE LA SASKATCHEWAN  
(Practice Directives)

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CRIMINAL PRACTICE DIRECTIVE NO. 9  
INEFFECTIVE ASSISTANCE OF TRIAL COUNSEL

Effective: June 1, 2020

The right to effective assistance of counsel extends to all accused persons. In criminal appeals, the appellant may raise grounds of appeal suggesting that trial counsel was ineffective, incompetent or otherwise contributed to a miscarriage of justice. For an appeal alleging ineffective assistance of trial counsel to succeed, it must be established that:

- (a) trial counsel's acts or omissions constituted incompetence; and
- (b) a miscarriage of justice resulted.

Incompetence is determined by a reasonableness standard. There is a strong presumption that counsel's conduct fell within the wide range of reasonable professional assistance. The onus is on the appellant to establish that the alleged acts or omissions of trial counsel were not the result of reasonable professional judgment: *R v GDB*, 2000 SCC 22.

**Application of practice directive**

- 1 This practice directive applies to those criminal appeals before the Court of Appeal for Saskatchewan in which the appellant advances as a basis of the appeal that trial counsel provided ineffective assistance at trial resulting in a miscarriage of justice.

**Review of notices of appeal by Registrar and Crown**

- 2(1) The registrar of the Court will review all notices of appeal filed in criminal appeals to determine if the appellant is advancing ineffective assistance of trial counsel as a basis for the appeal and will categorize each such notice of appeal using the categories described below.
- (2) Crown counsel who becomes aware that an appellant is raising such issues must notify the registrar.

**Appeal categories and initial process for each**

**Category A: Appeals by represented appellants**

- 3(1) If appeal counsel alleges ineffective assistance of trial counsel as a ground of appeal, appeal counsel should:
  - (a) be satisfied, by personal investigation or other appropriate inquiries, that some factual foundation exists for this allegation to be made, apart from the instructions of the appellant;
  - (b) provide trial counsel with informal notice of the general nature of the potential allegation of ineffective assistance;
  - (c) provide trial counsel with a waiver, if necessary, and a reasonable opportunity to respond to appeal counsel regarding the allegations; and
  - (d) consider trial counsel's response, if any, before proceeding with this ground of appeal.
- (2) If a notice of appeal or amended notice of appeal prepared and filed by appeal counsel contains an allegation of ineffective assistance of trial counsel, the registrar will take the following steps:
  - (a) schedule the appeal for appeal management;
  - (b) notify trial counsel of the allegation; and
  - (c) provide trial counsel with a copy of this practice directive.

**Category B: Appeals by self-represented appellants**

- 4(1) If a notice of appeal prepared and filed by a self-represented appellant contains an allegation of ineffective assistance of trial counsel, the registrar may:
  - (a) schedule the appeal in the ordinary course; or
  - (b) at the registrar's discretion, direct the appeal to appeal management.
- (2) If the registrar schedules the appeal, the panel of the Court hearing the appeal may consider and decide the appeal or may direct the appeal to appeal management.
- (3) If the appeal is directed to appeal management, the registrar will:
  - (a) set a date for appeal management;
  - (b) notify trial counsel of the allegation; and
  - (c) provide both the appellant and trial counsel with a copy of this practice directive.



**Initial considerations for trial counsel**

5(1) If trial counsel receives notification of an allegation of ineffective assistance of trial counsel, either from appeal counsel or from the registrar, trial counsel should locate and maintain trial counsel's file relating to the criminal prosecution. Trial counsel is encouraged to contact the Saskatchewan Lawyers' Insurance Association (SLIA) with regard to file management and transfer.

(2) If the allegation proceeds to an appeal hearing, trial counsel should be aware that the Court may order the disclosure of trial counsel's file to some or all parties to the appeal and that the file may be made available to the Court.

**Appeal management process****Appeal management judge**

6(1) Appeal management proceedings are scheduled before a judge of the Court in chambers pursuant to Rule 32 of *The Court of Appeal Criminal Appeal Rules (Saskatchewan)*.

(2) Once a judge of the Court has commenced appeal management on an appeal, that judge may continue with appeal management for as long as the judge considers it necessary and advisable to do so.

**Waiver of solicitor/client privilege**

7(1) In some cases, the trial record may suffice as an evidential basis for an allegation of ineffective assistance of trial counsel leading to a miscarriage of justice. In other cases, the allegations may pertain to matters that occurred between the appellant and trial counsel that are not reflected in the record. In these latter cases, fresh evidence on appeal may be necessary to enable proper consideration of the issue.

(2) If the contents of trial counsel's file are considered relevant to the appeal, a waiver of solicitor-client privilege will need to be provided by the appellant. The appeal management judge will canvass the issue of waiver and may set a timeline for dealing with this issue.

**Transfer of trial counsel's file**

8(1) If a waiver of solicitor-client privilege has been provided, trial counsel should, in the normal course, release trial counsel's original file to appeal counsel, or to the appellant if the appellant is self-represented. Trial counsel may, at trial counsel's own expense, retain a copy of the entire file or portions of the file if trial counsel wishes or is professionally obligated to do so.

(2) If trial counsel has any objection to the transfer of trial counsel's file, or parts of it, trial counsel should bring those objections to the attention of the appeal management judge forthwith. The appeal management judge may refer the issue to a panel of the Court for a determination.

(3) The appeal management judge may set a timeline for the provision of trial counsel's file. If this timeline is not met, the appellant may make an application to the Court for production of the file.

(4) The appeal management judge may give any further directions that the judge considers appropriate, including setting the appeal for hearing by the Court.

**Application for fresh evidence**

9(1) If the appellant is relying on more than the record as the evidentiary basis for an allegation of ineffective assistance of trial counsel, the appellant must file an application to adduce fresh evidence, supported by an affidavit.

(2) The application for fresh evidence will be heard by the Court at the same time as the appeal is heard unless the Court directs otherwise.

(3) The appeal management judge will set a timeline for the service and filing of the application and affidavit.

(4) If the timeline set pursuant to subsection (3) is not met, the appeal management judge may make any further order that the judge considers appropriate, or may refer the appeal to the Court to make any order that the Court considers just.

**Affidavit from trial counsel**

**10(1)** If trial counsel considers it appropriate to do so, trial counsel may file an affidavit in response to the fresh evidence application.

(2) If trial counsel intends to file an affidavit, the appeal management judge will set a timeline for the service and filing of the affidavit.

(3) If the timeline set pursuant to subsection (2) is not met, the appeal management judge may set a further timeline or make any further order that the judge considers appropriate, or may set the appeal for hearing by the Court.

**Cross-examination on affidavit**

**11(1)** Any party desiring to cross-examine an affiant must notify the appeal management judge, with notice to all other appeal management participants and trial counsel.

(2) The panel of the Court hearing the appeal shall determine whether cross-examination will be permitted.

**DIRECTIVE DE PRATIQUE CRIMINELLE N° 9  
ASSISTANCE NON EFFECTIVE DE L'AVOCAT DU PROCÈS**

En vigueur à compter du 1er juin 2020

Tout inculpé a droit à l'assistance effective d'un avocat. Dans les appels en matière criminelle, il se peut que l'appelant plaide comme moyen d'appel que l'avocat du procès était inefficace ou incompetent ou encore qu'il a concouru à la survenance d'une erreur judiciaire. Pour qu'un appel fondé sur l'assistance non effective de l'avocat du procès soit accueilli, il faut démontrer à la fois :

- a) que les actes ou les omissions de l'avocat relevaient de l'incompétence;
- b) qu'une erreur judiciaire en a résulté.

L'incompétence est appréciée au moyen de la norme du caractère raisonnable. Il y a une forte présomption que la conduite de l'avocat se situe à l'intérieur du large éventail de l'assistance professionnelle raisonnable. Il incombe à l'appelant de démontrer que les actes ou omissions reprochés à l'avocat ne découlaient pas de l'exercice d'un jugement professionnel raisonnable : voir *R c GDB*, 2000 CSC 22.

**Champ d'application de la directive de pratique**

**1** La présente directive de pratique s'applique aux appels en matière criminelle interjetés à la Cour d'appel de la Saskatchewan dans lesquels l'appelant plaide comme moyen d'appel que l'avocat du procès a fourni une assistance non effective au procès et qu'une erreur judiciaire en a résulté.

**Examen des avis d'appel par le registraire et le ministère public**

**2(1)** Le registraire de la Cour examine tous les avis d'appel déposés en matière criminelle pour cerner ceux dans lesquels l'appelant plaide comme moyen d'appel l'assistance non effective de l'avocat du procès, puis trie ces derniers suivant les catégories établies ci-dessous.

(2) Tout avocat du ministère public qui apprend qu'un appelant soulève ce genre de questions doit en aviser le registraire.

**Catégories d'appel et procédure introductive pour chacune d'elle**

**Catégorie A : Appels d'appelants représentés par avocat**

**3(1)** Tout avocat d'appel qui plaide comme moyen d'appel l'assistance non effective de l'avocat du procès doit :

- a) s'assurer, par vérification personnelle ou d'autres enquêtes appropriées, qu'il existe un fondement factuel à cette allégation à part les instructions de l'appelant;

- b) aviser informellement l'avocat du procès de la nature générale de l'allégation éventuelle d'assistance non effective;
  - c) fournir, au besoin, une renonciation à l'avocat du procès, et donner à celui-ci une période raisonnable pour lui répondre au sujet des allégations;
  - d) prendre en considération la réponse de l'avocat du procès, le cas échéant, avant de donner suite à ce moyen d'appel.
- (2) Lorsqu'un avis d'appel ou un avis d'appel modifié rédigé et déposé par l'avocat d'appel contient une allégation d'assistance non effective de l'avocat du procès, le registraire prend les mesures suivantes :
- a) il inscrit l'appel au programme de la gestion des appels;
  - b) il avise l'avocat du procès de l'allégation;
  - c) il remet à l'avocat du procès copie de la présente directive de pratique.

**Catégorie B : Appels d'appelants qui se représentent eux-mêmes**

- 4(1) Lorsqu'un avis d'appel rédigé et déposé par un appelant qui se représente lui-même contient une allégation d'assistance non effective de l'avocat du procès, le registraire peut :
- a) soit inscrire l'appel au rôle comme à l'accoutumée;
  - b) soit, à son gré, acheminer l'appel vers la gestion des appels.
- (2) Dans le cas où le registraire inscrit l'appel au rôle, la formation de juges saisie de l'appel peut juger l'appel ou l'acheminer vers la gestion des appels.
- (3) Dans le cas où l'appel est acheminé vers la gestion des appels, le registraire doit :
- a) fixer une date pour la gestion de l'appel;
  - b) aviser l'avocat du procès de l'allégation;
  - c) remettre à l'appelant ainsi qu'à l'avocat du procès copie de la présente directive de pratique.

**Démarches initiales de l'avocat du procès**

- 5(1) L'avocat du procès qui est avisé d'une allégation d'assistance non effective de sa part, soit par l'avocat d'appel, soit par le registraire, commence par se procurer son dossier relatif à la poursuite pénale. Il est encouragé à communiquer avec la Saskatchewan Lawyers' Insurance Association (SLIA) pour ce qui a trait à la gestion et au transfert du dossier.
- (2) L'avocat du procès doit savoir que, si l'allégation se rend en appel, la Cour pourra ordonner la divulgation du dossier de l'avocat du procès à tout ou partie des parties à l'appel et le dossier pourra être mis à la disposition de la Cour.

**Processus de gestion de l'appel**

**Juge chargé de la gestion de l'appel**

- 6(1) La gestion de l'appel est confiée à un juge de la Cour siégeant en cabinet, conformément à la règle 32 des *Règles de la Cour d'appel régissant les appels en matière criminelle (Saskatchewan)*.
- (2) Une fois chargé de la gestion de l'appel, le juge peut continuer de s'en occuper pendant autant de temps qu'il estime nécessaire et souhaitable.

**Renonciation au privilège avocat-client**

- 7(1) Dans certains cas, le dossier du procès peut s'avérer un fondement probant suffisant à une allégation d'assistance non effective aboutissant à une erreur judiciaire. Dans d'autres cas, les allégations peuvent se rapporter à des choses qui se sont passées entre l'appelant et l'avocat du procès et qui ne paraissent pas dans le dossier. Dans ces derniers cas, la présentation de nouvelles preuves peut s'avérer nécessaire en appel pour que la question puisse être examinée convenablement.

(2) Si le contenu du dossier de l'avocat du procès s'avère pertinent dans l'appel, l'appelant doit fournir une renonciation au privilège avocat-client. Le juge chargé de la gestion de l'appel se penche alors sur la question de la renonciation et peut fixer un échéancier pour le traitement de cette question.

**Transfert du dossier de l'avocat du procès**

8(1) Une fois la renonciation au privilège avocat-client fournie, l'avocat du procès procède, dans les délais normaux, à la remise de son dossier original à l'avocat d'appel ou, si l'appelant se représente lui-même, à ce dernier. L'avocat du procès peut, à ses frais, conserver une copie de tout ou partie du dossier, s'il le désire ou si ses fonctions professionnelles l'en obligent.

(2) S'il conteste le transfert de tout ou partie de son dossier, l'avocat du procès doit en faire part sans délai au juge chargé de la gestion de l'appel, qui peut déférer la question à une formation de juges de la Cour pour décision.

(3) Le juge chargé de la gestion de l'appel peut fixer un échéancier pour la remise du dossier de l'avocat du procès. Si cet échéancier n'est pas respecté, l'appelant peut s'adresser à la Cour pour obtenir la production du dossier.

(4) Le juge chargé de la gestion de l'appel peut donner toute autre directive qu'il estime indiquée et inscrire l'appel au rôle de la Cour.

**Demande visant la présentation de nouvelles preuves**

9(1) Si le dossier judiciaire ne lui suffit pas comme fondement probant à une allégation d'assistance non effective de l'avocat du procès, l'appelant dépose une demande visant la présentation de nouveaux éléments de preuve, appuyée d'un affidavit.

(2) La demande visant la présentation de nouvelles preuves est entendue par la Cour en même temps que l'appel, sauf ordre contraire.

(3) Le juge chargé de la gestion de l'appel fixe un échéancier pour la signification et le dépôt de la demande et de l'affidavit.

(4) Si l'échéancier prévu au paragraphe (3) n'est pas respecté, le juge chargé de la gestion de l'appel peut rendre toute autre ordonnance qu'il estime indiquée, ou déférer l'appel à la Cour pour qu'elle rende toute ordonnance qu'elle estime juste.

**Affidavit de l'avocat du procès**

10(1) S'il l'estime indiqué, l'avocat du procès peut déposer un affidavit en réponse à la demande visant la présentation de nouvelles preuves.

(2) Dans le cas où l'avocat du procès entend déposer un affidavit, le juge chargé de la gestion de l'appel fixe un échéancier pour la signification et le dépôt de l'affidavit.

(3) Si l'échéancier prévu au paragraphe (2) n'est pas respecté, le juge chargé de la gestion de l'appel peut fixer un nouvel échéancier, rendre toute autre ordonnance qu'il estime indiquée ou inscrire l'appel au rôle de la Cour.

**Contre-interrogatoire visant l'affidavit**

11(1) Toute partie qui désire contre-interroger l'auteur d'un affidavit doit en aviser le juge chargé de la gestion de l'appel ainsi que tous les autres participants au processus de gestion de l'appel et l'avocat du procès.

(2) Il appartient à la formation de juges de la Cour qui entend l'appel d'admettre ou non le contre-interrogatoire.
