May 29, 2020	Accelerated Site Closure Program	BT 2020-013

In follow-up to [Bulletin BT 2020-011](#) announcing the launch of the Accelerated Site Closure Program (ASCP), the following additional information can be provided at this time.

- Funding allocations for Phase 1 of the ASCP have been completed. Eligible licenses will receive notice of their allocation amounts starting on Monday June 1, 2020. If you have questions on your eligibility or the amount of funding allocated, please contact the ER Service Desk at 1-855-219-9373 or ER.servicedesk@gov.sk.ca starting on Tuesday, June 2, 2020.
- SaskBuilds is notifying Saskatchewan-based Oil Field Service (OFS) contractors and environmental consultants of invitation-only Town Hall information sessions being held June 2-3, 2020. These meetings will engage firms that manage site closure, remediating, and reclamation services.

A similar session is being held June 9, 2020, in partnership with the Saskatchewan Industrial and Mining Suppliers Association (SIMSA). This session will engage companies that provide specific skilled-trade, technical, or peripheral services related to oil and gas sites to OFS and environmental consulting companies or directly to oil and gas producers themselves. Information on this session will be released to industry stakeholders shortly through SIMSA.

If you are a Saskatchewan-based contractor, consultant, or service company and have not received a notification for the June 2 or 3 sessions through SaskBuilds by 8:00 am Monday, June 1, 2020, please contact Brenda Maximuik at brenda.maximuik@gov.sk.ca with your company name, phone number, and Saskatchewan location in order to be considered.

- At this time, procedures for the nomination of wells and facilities using the Integrated Resource Information System (IRIS) are still in development. Your patience is appreciated as we continue to finalize these procedures. The Ministry of Energy and Resources will notify licensees once those procedures have been updated on the website and will post a date for when nominations for wells and facilities will begin to be received.
