June 11, 2020	Updated version of Directive S-01 in effect	BT2020-017

On June 11, 2020 an updated version of *Directive S-01: Saskatchewan Upstream Petroleum Industry Storage Standards* came into effect. The in-force version of the directive can be found at [here](#). Please ensure that your organization is aware of and follows the requirements as outlined in the directive.

The directive features certain revisions to support recent updates to the Integrated Resource Information System (IRIS). Notable changes include:

- Clarity on licensed facility siting, setbacks and equipment spacing (sections 2.1 and 2.2);
- The removal of the option for licensees to submit their own spill response plan (section 2.3);
- Additional information on the required setbacks from abandoned wells (Appendix 2); and
- Requirements for pressure safety valves and pop tanks (Appendix 5).

Additional terms have been added to the Glossary to better align with other directives.

Although no formal consultation with industry was undertaken, licensees were invited to provide comment in demonstrations that were conducted by the Ministry of Energy and Resources (ER) to illustrate the changes to IRIS and the changes to S-01.
