NSEQC Vision

A committee, composed of trusted and knowledgeable people each nominated by his/her community, to be a bridge between northerners, government and the development industry of northern Saskatchewan - a bridge built upon a solid foundation of mutual trust and respect.

NSEQC Mission

Through informed dialogue and communication, government, the uranium mining industry and the people of the north, together, will strive to ensure that all uranium mining activity takes place in a manner which considers the needs and aspirations of those people most directly affected, the people of northern Saskatchewan.

NSEQC Authority

The Northern Saskatchewan Environmental Quality Committee is not vested with regulatory responsibilities, but rather is structured to provide a forum which will ensure consideration of the concerns and recommendations of northerners on the way in which natural resource development occurs in northern Saskatchewan.
