Effective September 14, 2017, the employee was terminated from employment with SHA.</p> <p>RCMP concluded their investigation and the case went before the court.</p> <p>A court order was released on October 9, 2020 finding the terminated employee guilty of deceit, falsehood or other fraudulent means, and defraud of SHA of money exceeding five thousand dollars.</p>
