Festival of Lights

Pike Lake Festival of Lights is back again! Enjoy the twinkling light displays, sponsored by local businesses, from the comfort of your own car.

Special Park Activity Kits (PAKs) will be available for pick-up upon arrival at the entry gate during the festival.

Festival will begin once dark (around 5:30 pm). No vehicles will be permitted entry past 9:45 pm.

Festival of Lights is free to attend with valid park entry. Bring your Sask Parks annual park entry permit or purchase entry at the park (\$10 per vehicle).

Outdoor Adventure

- Step into your snowshoes and onto the Gift of Green Nature Trail. Keep your eyes peeled for Pike Lake's famously friendly chickadees! Snowshoe rentals will be available between December 17, 2020 and March 7, 2021. Rates are \$5/day for youth (under 18) and \$10/day for adults. Inquire at the entry gate on weekends or the admin office on weekdays. A "Snowshoeing Basics" handout will be available for anyone who is new to the activity. - Did you know Pike Lake has a 5 kilometer cross-country ski trail? This groomed trail located by the Pike Lake Golf Course is perfect for a day of cross-country skiing and offers beautiful views of the park with multiple scenic lookout points. Please bring your own skis.

Outdoor Fun for All Ages!

- Do you like curling? What about Crokinole? Then we have you covered with Crokicurl! You can try your hand at this winter sport every weekend by the Rec Hall. Offered during park operating hours, first-come, first-serve. Rocks will be cleaned multiple times during the day.
- Lace up your skates! Pike Lake will have skating on the canal located behind the Rec Hall for you and the family to enjoy. From beginners to Olympians, everyone is welcome to skate the lake! Please bring your own skates.
- Stop by the Rec Hall and grab an outdoor Park Activity Kit (PAK)! These PAKs are designed to bring the joy of play and nature exploration to your family without the need to gather in large groups.
- It's time for a new family photo! Start at the Rec Hall and look for the Pike Lake Photo Hop sign. Follow the prompts on the sign to help you find fun, wild, and silly areas in the park to complete the listed photo opportunities. Be as creative as you want and show us on social media by tagging #SaskParks on Facebook and Instagram.
- Have you built a fairy house at the park in the summer? Winter fairies need homes too. Stop by the Rec Hall to find coloured ice blocks waiting to become a winter fairy castle or other creative design.
