Outdoor Adventure

- Bring your cross-country skis and glide peacefully through the forest on set tracks or skate ski. Approximately 10 km of groomed trails are available with new directional signage, plus 2.8 km of dog-friendly trails and two warmup shelters. Get a trail map from the Visitor Centre, then make your way to the Little Mclean campgrounds to find the trail heads.
- Echo Valley offers of an abundance of hiking trails, so pack your snowshoes and a warm pair of boots and hike with ease. Snowshoes are available to rent from the Visitor Centre (\$5/day for youth (under 18) and \$10/day for adults); pick-up a trail map while you're there!
- Access to Pasqua Lake is available for ice-fishing. Bring your gear and try your luck! Fishing licenses are required for Saskatchewan residents aged 16-64. Purchase your fishing license from <https://www.saskatchewanhal.ca/licensing.page> or at the Administration Office/Visitor Centre.

Outdoor Fun for All Ages!

- Build an ice castle! Take a short walk to the interpretive campfire to find coloured ice blocks waiting to be stacked into a castle for the park's fairies, elves and gnomes.
- Looking for a treasure hunt? Check out the winter caching course and see if you can find your way to the prize! The course starts at the Visitor Centre. Bring your snowshoes for added fun!
- It's time for a new family photo! Start at the Visitor Centre, and look for the Echo Valley Photo Hop sign. Follow the prompts on the sign to help you find fun, wild, and silly areas in the park to complete the listed photo opportunities. Be as creative as you want and show us on social media by tagging #SaskParks on Facebook and Instagram.
- Grab an outdoor Pick-up Park Activity Kit (PAK) from the Visitor Centre. These self-use activities will take you and your family through a variety of fun outdoor activities!
