**CHAPTER 1-29\***

An Act granting to Her Majesty certain sums of Money for the Public Service for the Fiscal Years ending on March 31, 2021

(Assented to December 10, 2020)

**MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN:**

Whereas it appears by a message from the Honourable the Lieutenant Governor of Saskatchewan, and the estimates accompanying the message, that the sums mentioned in this Act are required to defray certain charges and expenses of the public service of Saskatchewan not otherwise provided for during the fiscal years ending respectively on March 31, 2020 and on March 31, 2021;

May it therefore please Your Majesty, that it may be enacted and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, as follows:

**Short title**

**1** This Act may be cited as *The Appropriation Act, 2020 (No. 2)*.

**General revenue fund**

**2** There may be paid out of the general revenue fund a sum not exceeding \$482,000,000 to be applied towards defraying the charges and expenses of the public service for the fiscal year ending on March 31, 2021, not otherwise provided for, and being the amount of each of the sums granted, as set forth in Schedule A.

**Accounting**

**3** The application of all moneys expended pursuant to this Act shall be accounted for to Her Majesty.

**Coming into force**

**4** This Act comes into force on assent and remains in force until October 31, 2021.

### Schedule A

**\*Note:** Due to the timing of the Fall 2020 General Election and a new numbering system for Acts, three Acts passed in the First Session of the 29th Legislature in the Fall of 2020 would have had duplicate numbers to three Acts that were passed in the Fourth Session of the 28th Legislature in the Spring of 2020. In order to distinguish between Chapters 1, 2 and 3 in the 28th and 29th Legislatures, the Chapter numbers assigned denote the Legislature in which they were passed.
