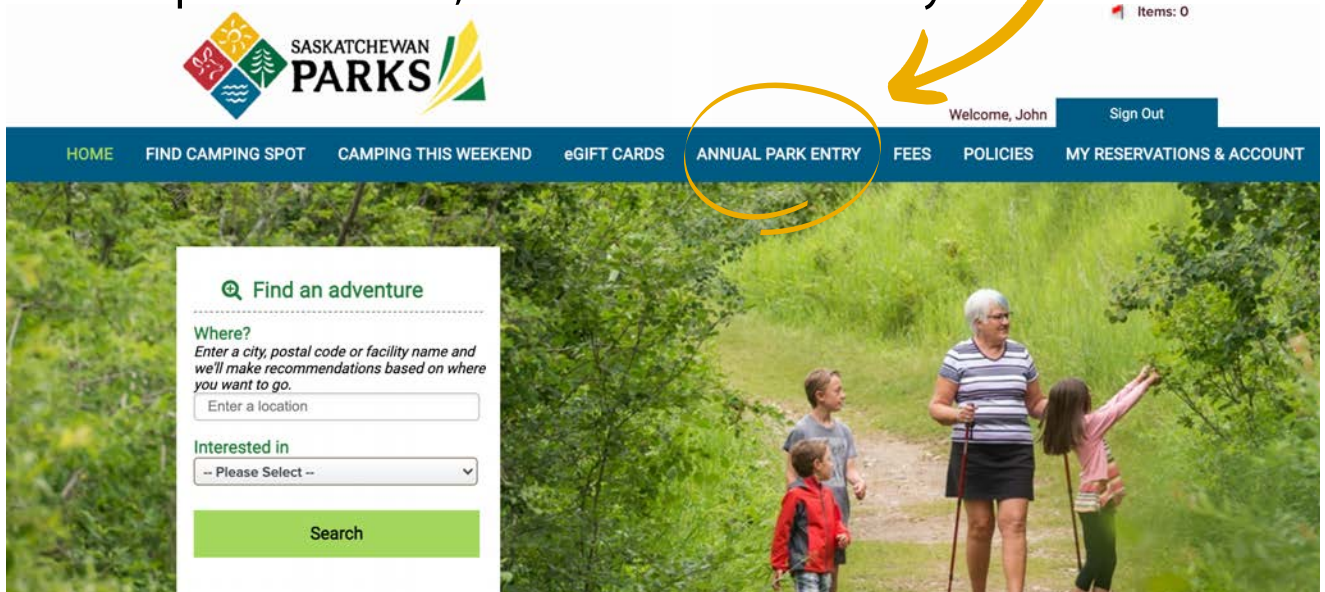


# PURCHASE A STANDALONE PARK ENTRY PERMIT

## Annual Vehicle Permit

Annual park entry permits are a great way to ensure you can enjoy Saskatchewan Provincial Parks year round. A valid vehicle entry permit is required on all vehicles while in a provincial park.

If you purchased an annual vehicle entry permit before May 1, the permit will be mailed to the mailing address associated with your reservation.

For annual vehicle entry permits purchased from May 1 to March 30 of the following year, you will need to pick up your permit when you arrive at the park.

#### Saskatchewan Provincial Parks Policies and Rules

- A \$12 reservation fee covers the cost of administering the reservation service. An additional \$2 surcharge will apply to all transactions using the call centre.
- You may change or cancel your reservation by visiting [parks.saskatchewan.ca](http://parks.saskatchewan.ca) or by calling the Saskatchewan Provincial Parks Reservation Call Centre at 1-833-775-7275.
- Reservation, change and cancellation fees are non-refundable.
- Where a refundable damage deposit is required, this must be paid in full at the time of reservation. If no damage occurs during your stay, you will be refunded the damage deposit.
- Change and cancellation penalties are based on the type of site reserved and outlined under Fees and Policies on [parks.saskatchewan.ca](http://parks.saskatchewan.ca). If a change or cancellation is not covered by these penalties, Saskatchewan Provincial Parks will apply the relevant transaction/penalty charges if you:
  - Shorten any dates on a reservation.
  - Change arrival date, except to extend a reservation by arriving earlier.
  - Downgrade to a lower-priced site or activity.
