Re-Open Saskatchewan

Re-Open Saskatchewan is a plan built on a methodical and phased-in approach to slowly and responsibly lift restrictions on businesses and services.

General Restrictions

As of July 11, 2021, all general or remaining restrictions previously announced in the Re-Open Saskatchewan plan have been lifted.

Public Health Orders

In response to the public health risks of COVID-19, the Chief Medical Health Officer issues public health orders under the authority of *The Public Health Act, 1994*.

As of July 11, 2021, all public health orders in Saskatchewan have been rescinded.
