

Public Notice

The Saskatchewan Highway Patrol is scheduled for a Virtual “On-Site” assessment as part of a program to achieve accreditation, by verifying it meets professional standards.

Administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA), the accreditation program requires agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards in four basic areas: Policy and Procedures, Administration, Operations and Support Services.

As part of the assessment, members of the Public are invited to offer comments at a “Virtual” Information Session on November 29, 2021, between 3:15 and 5:15 PM, Central Standard Time. Those wishing to participate can send an email to SHPAccred@gov.sk.ca indicating their desire to provide comments to the CALEA Assessment Team. Those requesting attendance will then be provided with a WebEx link for access to the public information session.

Members of the Public are also invited to offer comments by calling 306-787-9094 on November 29, 2021 between the hours of 1:00 and 3:00 PM, Central Standard Time. Comments will be taken by the CALEA Assessment Team.

Telephone comments as well as appearances at the “Virtual” Public Information Session are limited to 10 minutes and must address the Saskatchewan Highway Patrol’s ability to comply with CALEA’s standards.
