## Fentanyl Testing Strips



1

Put your drugs (amount equal to a few grains of sand) into 30mL/1oz (amount equal to a shot glass) of room temperature tap water



2

Stir or shake contents until sample is dissolved completely



3

Dip the strip into the cup for **15 seconds**, no deeper than **the wavy line**



4

Wait 1 minute for red lines to appear

5



**1 LINE:**  
**YES** fentanyl



**2 LINES:**  
**NO** fentanyl

Strips cannot detect all types of fentanyl,  
such as carfentanyl.

**A NEGATIVE TEST RESULT DOES NOT MEAN THE SUBSTANCE IS SAFE**
