### About

IRIS Version 9.1 Release implemented 20 items. Multiple enhancements and modifications in relation to Pipelines and Flowline Incidents have been introduced. A notification has been added for Helium Exploratory Permit holders. The overall login experience has been improved. To access IRIS, users will select either the *Industry Login* or *Government of Saskatchewan Login* box. As well, various enhancements and fixes to known defects were implemented to the Infrastructure, Petroleum Tenure and Security Modules.

### What's changed?

The highlights of what's changed in IRIS as a result of this release are noted below.

**Note:** Whether a user has access to the functionality or enhancements outlined in these 9.1 Release Notes depends on the individual's security access and assigned permissions sets.

### Infrastructure Functionality

A *Segment Identifier* field has been added to *Pipeline Incidents* in the *Incidents* module, and a new *Source Type* of *Licensed Flowline* has been introduced which will require users to provide the *Flowline Licence* and *Segment Identifier*. Existing *Flowline Incidents* have been relabeled as having a *Source Type* of *Unlicensed Flowline*, and users can optionally change the *Source Type* to *Licensed Flowline* to provide either the *Licence* number or both the *Licence* and *Segment Identifier*. New *Unlicensed Flowline* incidents must be associated to a well licence number as reported in the past. A new *Event Type* called *Incident Report* will be created on the *Licences* and *Segments* identified in an *Incident* report.

## Petroleum Tenure Module

A new courtesy notification for Helium Exploratory Permit holders has been implemented with this release. Lessees and Confidential Designated Representatives can subscribe to a 'Reminder for Application for Lease Selection for Helium Exploratory Permits' notification via the *Notification Preferences* screen. The notification is a reminder to advise that there are 30 days prior to the Next Review Date to submit an *Application for Extension* and 2 months after the Next Review Date to submit an *Application for Lease Selection*.

## Security Module

The IRIS login experience has been enhanced. When a user accesses the IRIS Login screen, they will see two Login boxes – one for *Industry Login* and one for *Government of Saskatchewan Login*.

### Industry Users:

- Type *User name* and *Password*
- Click the  to confirm you are not a robot
- Click the  to read, understand and accept IRIS's Terms and Conditions.
- And click *Log In*.
