Canadian Navigable Waters Act

The Saskatchewan Ministry of Highways hereby gives notice that a submission has been added to the Navigable Waters Registry pursuant to the Canadian Navigable Waters Act for public comment described herein and its description.

Pursuant to paragraph 10(1)(b) of the said Act, the Saskatchewan Ministry of Highways has deposited with the Ministry of Transport, on the on-line Common Project Search Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and under the registry number **5405** a description of the following work:

Bridge Replacement on Highway 120, C.S. 120-02 km 44.02 over White Gull Creek, approximately 44 km north east of the Highway 265 junction to Candle Lake.
