“(cc) Deputy Chief Firearms Officers and Firearms Officers with respect to the conduct of investigations pursuant to their appointment as special constables pursuant to section 76 of *The Police Act, 1990*”; **and**

**(f) by adding the following clause after clause (cc):**

“(dd) the Serious Incident Response Team established pursuant to section 91.01 of *The Police Act, 1990*”.

“(dd) the Chief Firearms Officer, with respect to the conduct of investigations pursuant to the Acts and regulations that the Chief Firearms Officer administers and any laws of Canada that are enforced by officers and employees of the Chief Firearms Officer;

“(ee) Deputy Chief Firearms Officers and Firearms Officers with respect to the conduct of investigations pursuant to their appointment as special constables pursuant to section 76 of *The Police Act, 1990*”; **and**

**(f) by adding the following clause after clause (ee):**

“(ff) the Serious Incident Response Team established pursuant to section 91.01 of *The Police Act, 1990*”.

**Section 2 amended**

**3** **Clause 2(b) is amended by striking out “section 8” and substituting “section 10 or 10.1”.**

**4** **Clause 6(a) is amended by striking out “subsection 9(2)” and substituting “section 6.01 and subsection 9(2)”.**

**New section 6.01**

**5** **The following section is added after section 6:**

**“Offence notice ticket – Part IV.1 of Act**

**6.01** The offences pursuant to clauses 235(5)(a) and 235(6)(a) of *The Traffic Safety Act* for which a photograph or video was obtained through the use of a red light camera system are designated as offences for which proceedings may be commenced pursuant to Part IV.1 of the Act by the issuance of an offence notice ticket”.

**Section 10 amended**

**6** **Subsection 10(1) is amended by striking out “Form A” and substituting “Subject to section 10.1, Form A”.**

**New section 10.1**

**7** **The following section is added after section 10:**

**“Form of ticket – certain offence notice tickets**

**10.1(1)** Form A.1 of Part 1 of the Appendix is prescribed as the form of the summary offence ticket for the offences designated in section 6.01 as offences for which proceedings may be commenced pursuant to Part IV.1 of the Act by the issuance of an offence notice ticket.

(2) The ticket mentioned in subsection (1) consists of the following six parts:

- (a) Parts 1 and 2 to be used for laying an information and as the certificate of service;
- (b) Part 3 to be used to issue an offence notice with respect to any offence mentioned in subsection (1);
- (c) Part 4 to be used by the person to whom an offence notice is directed for payment of a specified penalty sum pursuant to section 10 of the Act;
- (d) Part 5 to be used as the police record of the information; and
- (e) Part 6 to be used as the peace officer’s case summary notes”.

**New section 11****8 Section 11 is repealed and the following substituted:****“Use of ticket**

**11(1)** Parts 1, 2, 5 and 6 of the ticket set out in Form A are to be used for all summons ticket offences.

(2) Parts 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the ticket set out in Form A are to be used for all offence notice tickets, other than for an offence mentioned in section 6.01.

(3) Parts 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the ticket set out in Form A.1 are to be used for all offence notice tickets for an offence mentioned in section 6.01.

(4) Parts 7 and 8 of the ticket set out in Form A and Parts 5 and 6 of the ticket set out in Form A.1 are to be used if a peace officer:

(a) lays an information or issues a summons for an offence that is not a voluntary payment offence; or

(b) issues a summons or an offence notice for a voluntary payment offence and the defendant does not make the voluntary payment”.

**4(1)** **Clause 6(1)(b) is repealed and the following substituted:**

“(b) **‘non-immigrant’** means a person:

(i) who has been lawfully admitted to Canada;

(ii) who:

(A) is a member of the clergy or member of a religious order and is in Saskatchewan for the purpose of carrying out religious duties;

(B) is a student who is in full-time attendance at an educational institution in Saskatchewan;

(C) is engaged in a legitimate profession, trade or occupation and is in Saskatchewan for the temporary exercise of a calling or for the purpose of receiving training that is promoted by a ministry of the Government of Saskatchewan and is related to that calling;



(D) has been allowed to enter and remain in Canada under authority of a permit issued by the Minister of Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada;

(E) has been allowed to remain in Canada under authority of a visa, permit or visitor record issued by the Minister of Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada pursuant to the Canada-Ukraine Authorization for Emergency Travel (CUAET) program established by the Government of Canada; or

(F) is the spouse or a dependant of a person mentioned in paragraphs (A) to (E); and

(iii) who establishes residence in Saskatchewan before the first day of the third month after having been so admitted”.

**(2) Subsections 6(2) and (3) are repealed and the following substituted:**

“(2) Subject to subsections (3), (3.1), (6) and (7), for the purposes of section 12 of the Act, a special resident becomes a beneficiary on establishing residence in Saskatchewan.

“(3) Subject to subsection (3.1), a non-immigrant qualifies as a beneficiary during the period that the person’s visa or permit, and any additional visa or permit issued to that person, is valid.

“(3.1) A non-immigrant under the CUAET program mentioned in paragraph (1)(b)(ii)(E) qualifies as a beneficiary from January 1, 2022 and during the period that the person’s visa, permit or visitor record issued pursuant to the CUAET program is valid”.

- (b) any greater amount that the Lieutenant Governor in Council may approve.

**(2)** In the case of an applicant applying for a grant pursuant to the Feature Film and Television Production Grant Program established by the agency, the aggregate amount of financial assistance that the agency may approve for that applicant pursuant to sections 7 and 7.1 in a fiscal year from moneys granted to the agency by the minister or appropriated by the Legislature is not to exceed:

- (a) \$5,000,000; or
- (b) any greater amount that the Lieutenant Governor in Council may approve”.
