

“(xiv) for services provided in the period commencing on April 1, 2021 and ending on September 30, 2021, the schedule adopted by the ministry for payment of physician services and entitled ‘Saskatchewan Health Payment Schedule for Insured Services Provided by a Physician, April 1, 2021’, as amended by the Saskatchewan Ministry of Health Physicians’ Newsletter Number 54, dated April 1, 2021; and

3 Clause 5(1)(k) is repealed and the following substituted:

“(k) an employee of the Government of Saskatchewan whose ordinary residence is in Canada and who is required to reside outside of Canada by reason of the person’s employment with the Government of Saskatchewan”.

Section 6 amended

4(1) Clause 6(1)(b) is repealed and the following substituted:

“(b) ‘**non-immigrant**’ means a person:

(i) who has been lawfully admitted to Canada;

(ii) who:

(A) is a member of the clergy or member of a religious order and is in Saskatchewan for the purpose of carrying out religious duties;

(B) is a student who is in full-time attendance at an educational institution in Saskatchewan;

(C) is engaged in a legitimate profession, trade or occupation and is in Saskatchewan for the temporary exercise of a calling or for the purpose of receiving training that is promoted by a ministry of the Government of Saskatchewan and is related to that calling;

(D) has been allowed to enter and remain in Canada under authority of a permit issued by the Minister of Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada;

(E) has been allowed to remain in Canada under authority of a visa, permit or visitor record issued by the Minister of Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada pursuant to the Canada-Ukraine Authorization for Emergency Travel (CUAET) program established by the Government of Canada; or

(F) is the spouse or a dependant of a person mentioned in paragraphs (A) to (E); and

(iii) who establishes residence in Saskatchewan before the first day of the third month after having been so admitted”.

(2) Subsections 6(2) and (3) are repealed and the following substituted:

“(2) Subject to subsections (3), (3.1), (6) and (7), for the purposes of section 12 of the Act, a special resident becomes a beneficiary on establishing residence in Saskatchewan.

“(3) Subject to subsection (3.1), a non-immigrant qualifies as a beneficiary during the period that the person’s visa or permit, and any additional visa or permit issued to that person, is valid.

“(3.1) A non-immigrant under the CUAET program mentioned in paragraph (1)(b)(ii)(E) qualifies as a beneficiary from January 1, 2022 and during the period that the person’s visa, permit or visitor record issued pursuant to the CUAET program is valid”.

8(1) Subject to subsection (2), the aggregate amount of financial assistance that the agency may approve for an applicant pursuant to sections 7 and 7.1 in a fiscal year from moneys granted to the agency by the minister or appropriated by the Legislature is not to exceed:

- (a) \$750,000; or
- (b) any greater amount that the Lieutenant Governor in Council may approve.

(2) In the case of an applicant applying for a grant pursuant to the Feature Film and Television Production Grant Program established by the agency, the aggregate amount of financial assistance that the agency may approve for that applicant pursuant to sections 7 and 7.1 in a fiscal year from moneys granted to the agency by the minister or appropriated by the Legislature is not to exceed:

- (a) \$5,000,000; or
- (b) any greater amount that the Lieutenant Governor in Council may approve”.
