

Saskatchewan Quarterly Population Report

Second Quarter 2022

TOTAL POPULATION

Saskatchewan's population was estimated to be 1,194,803 as of July 1, 2022, according to Statistics Canada. This is an increase of 6,465 persons since April 1, 2022, and an increase of 13,310 persons from July 1, 2021. The second quarter (April 1 – June 30) saw Saskatchewan's population increase by 0.54 per cent, the eighth highest among the ten provinces.

Table 1 shows the quarterly population estimates and growth rates for Saskatchewan, Manitoba, and Alberta over the past two years.

Saskatchewan's annual population growth rate (1.13%) was the third lowest among the provinces. Prince Edward Island had the largest annual growth rates among the provinces. Table 2 shows the July 1, 2022, population estimates for all provinces and territories along with their quarterly and annual growth rates.

NATURAL INCREASE

Saskatchewan had 3,639 births and 2,591 deaths during the second quarter of 2022 producing a natural increase of 1,048. The natural increase in the same period last year was 1,120.

MIGRATION

Preliminary data suggests that in the second quarter of 2022, 6,992 Canadian residents moved to Saskatchewan as 8,940 Canadian residents left the province for a net interprovincial loss of 1,948 persons. In the second quarter of 2021, Saskatchewan had a net interprovincial migration loss of 2,536 persons.

Alberta was the primary source of Saskatchewan's interprovincial migration movement (37.99 per cent of in-migration and 41.53 per cent of out-migration).

Table 3 provides origin and destination flows of interprovincial migrants for the April 1, 2022 to June 30, 2022 period.

Net international migration added 7,365 people to Saskatchewan in the second quarter of 2022. This is an increase from 3,857 people in the first quarter of 2022. In the second quarter of 2021, net international migration was 1,869.

Figure 1 shows the Saskatchewan components of population change and growth rates in the second quarter.

Figure 1: Saskatchewan Components of Population Change 2nd Quarter (April 1 – June 30)

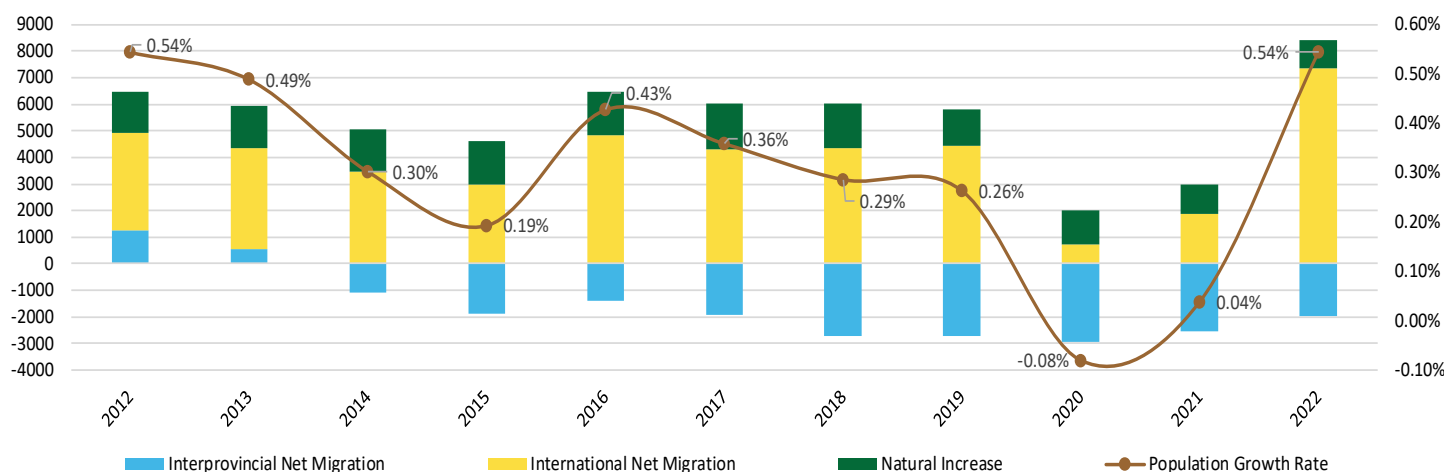
