About

IRIS Version 9.4 Release implemented **16** items. New functionality has been added for Industry users reporting on the presence of a *Surface Casing Vent Flow* on a well. An enhancement has been made to *Reporting Facility Obligations* to identify the responsible BA (Business Associate) in the case of amalgamations and supporting functionality modified to ensure the surviving BA can fulfill these obligations. A declaration question has been added to the *Lease Selection Application* when *Helium Permit* is selected. As well, various enhancements and fixes to known defects were implemented to the Infrastructure, Petroleum Tenure and Security Modules.

What's changed?

The highlights of what's changed in IRIS as a result of this release are noted below.

Note: Whether a user has access to the functionality or enhancements outlined in these *9.4 Release Notes* depends on the individual's security access and assigned permissions sets.

Infrastructure Functionality

- Going forward, Industry users will be required to submit structured data when reporting the presence of a *Surface Casing Vent Flow* on a well. This functionality is similar to the existing reporting functionality for *Drill Stem Tests* and *Fluid Analysis*. When reporting the *Cut and Cap Abandonment* on a well, users will no longer be required to upload the *Surface Casing Vent Flow* form at that time, and instead will submit the form with the associated structured data on the *Tests* tab of the Well. In the event fluid or H₂S are present in the *Surface Casing Vent Flow* test data, a warning will appear notifying users to contact the appropriate Ministry Field Office immediately. - A change has been made to enhance *Reporting Facility Obligations* to identify the responsible BA (Business Associate) in the case of amalgamations. Going forward, BAs will be considered either

financially or operationally responsible for a *Reporting Facility Obligation*, which will enable the surviving BA of an amalgamation to view and fulfill *Reporting Facility Obligations*. The original BA at the time of the reporting production months remains financially responsible in terms of invoices and billing. The *IRIS Obligation* search, as well as the *Unfulfilled Obligations* and *IRIS Non-Compliance Detail* reports have been modified accordingly to ensure that the surviving BA can find these obligations See [Industry Tip](#) for further information.

Petroleum Tenure Module

- An enhancement has been implemented to the *Lease Selection Application*. When a *Helium Permit* is selected, the declaration question '*I declare that the application is due to a commercial discovery prior to the expiration of the Permit.*' will be presented.
