The Registered Music Teachers Act

THE SASKATCHEWAN REGISTERED MUSIC TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION — REGULATORY BYLAWS

The Association

(1.1) In these bylaws:

- (a) "**act**" means *The Registered Music Teachers Act, 2002*;
- (b) "**Association**" means the Saskatchewan Registered Music Teachers' Association;
- (c) "**administrative bylaw**" means a bylaw made in accordance with subsection 14(1) of *The Registered Music Teachers Act, 2002*;
- (d) "**regulatory bylaw**" means a bylaw made in accordance with subsection 14(2) of *The Registered Music Teachers Act, 2002*;
- (e) "**Executive Committee**" means the executive as set out in section 5.1 of the Act.

Objectives of the Association

(2.1) To promote the interest of teachers of music in Saskatchewan who are members of the Association.

(2.2) To encourage and foster the formation of local branches composed of members of the Association at suitable centres throughout Saskatchewan.

(2.3) To promote progressive ideas and methods in teaching of music; to encourage systematic preparation in the art of teaching and to stimulate the acquirement by its members of a high standard of musicianship and general culture.

(2.4) To develop and encourage interest in music as a credit in public, high school and university education.

(2.5) To promote and assist all movements designed to improve the teaching of music and foster the interest of the public in music and for these purposes to join with other societies and associations having like aims and objects in furthering these purposes.

(2.6) To promote and maintain the status of professional music teachers in the province.

Head Office of the Association

(3.1) The head office of the Association shall be in the Province of Saskatchewan at a place to be determined by the Executive Committee.

Local Associations

(4.1) Local associations at present in existence or which may be formed hereafter consisting of members of the Association shall be deemed to be affiliated with the Association. Such local groups or associations shall have as their objects the promotion of the interest of the Association in their vicinity. No person whose name is not on the register shall be entitled to vote on provincial matters at meetings or hold himself out as a member of the Association. Representation and submissions on matters within the scope of the Association may be made from time to time to the Executive Committee of the Association, and shall be dealt with by said committee or referred by it to the Association at the Annual Meeting or otherwise as may be deemed expedient by the Executive Committee. Local Associations may have such offices and prescribe such fees for membership as may be determined by the members of any such local association. With the approval of the Executive Committee, a group of members of the Association may establish a local group or association. In order to use the designation RMT, a person must be a member of the provincial Association.

Meeting of the Association. At that time an election will be held in accordance with section 5.1 to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the term of the vacant position.

Administrative Bylaws

(Editor's Note: Sections 5.1–5.10 are omitted from this publication.)

Regulatory Bylaws**(6.1) Code of Ethics:**

These are the ethical ideals for teachers of music in Saskatchewan.

The Saskatchewan Teacher will:

- (a) teach to best of his/her ability and always promote a positive professional image;
- (b) always respect the dignity of the student and the work of another teacher;
- (c) teach regardless of race, creed or color – all pupils shall be treated with consideration and patience;
- (d) regard as confidential any information received from other members regarding another member which might be construed in the public domain;
- (e) refrain from proselytizing another teacher's students by inducement, innuendo, or insinuation;
- (f) be willing to share ideas that would be useful to members and students by giving workshops or writing pedagogical articles for the SRMTA Newsletter;
- (g) stimulate a spirit of comradeship through workshops, master-classes, conferences, and serve on branch, provincial, or national councils;
- (h) educate the public on the importance of a professional qualified teacher;
- (i) continually upgrade and keep informed through workshops, periodicals, and conferences;
- (j) speak with one voice on provincial matters and always advocate on matters of concern for the professional musician and for the music student;
- (k) insist on the complete portability of membership from one province to another;
- (l) keep the public informed of SRMTA and what it means to study with a Registered Music Teacher;
- (m) be candid but kind and objective when advising a student of his/her abilities;

(n) have fair and honorable business practices at all times in dealing with pupils and the Association;

(o) teach music with the object of improving its prestige as an art form so as to enhance the status of the profession in the community;

(p) regard the art of music teaching as a continual process of self-education and improvement to develop professional excellence and to improve teaching ability and standards;

(q) advertise his/her services only in a professional manner that accurately reflects the member's credentials without inviting comparison with the qualifications of other members;

(r) Establish his/her own professional fees at levels that respect the range of fees generally accepted as appropriate by the association.

(6.2) Membership:

(a) The Executive Committee of the Association may admit an individual to be a member of the Association if the individual meets the requirements of section 18 of the Act;

(b) All applications for membership shall be made in writing to the registrar and shall be accompanied by:

- certificates of proficiency and character as determined by the provincial association;
- diploma or diplomas (including the pedagogy component);
- the required application fee and registration fee;

(c) The registration fee shall be returned to the applicant if the application is not approved by the Examining Board, consisting of the past president, the president, and the vice president;

(d) The membership certificates shall be signed by the president and the registrar;

(e) Any person who meets the qualifications for membership, Pre-Diploma Membership, Associate Membership, as the case may be, in the Association and who pays the required fees of the Association in the manner established by it, shall be entitled to membership in the Association and have their name entered in the register by the Executive Committee.

(6.3) Pre-Diploma Membership:

(a) Notwithstanding 6.2 above, the Executive Committee of the Association may admit to Pre-Diploma category of membership in the Association persons:

- who reside in Saskatchewan;
- who are eighteen years of age or older;
- who provide evidence of training in music and are teaching music in a professional capacity of a standard and quality of performance which, in the opinion of the Executive Committee, is equivalent to the standards and quality required of members;
- who has completed a minimum of all Grade 10 requirements; and
- within a three year period from the time of acceptance shall complete a degree or diploma, including the pedagogical component. At the completion of all requirements, the Pre Diploma member will be accepted as a full member;

(b) Pre-Diploma members shall be eligible to attend all Association and local meetings of members, but shall not be entitled to vote on provincial matters, nor to hold office or nominate or vote for officers of the provincial Association;

(c) Pre-Diploma members shall not advertise themselves as members of the Association, but as Pre-Diploma members of the Association and shall not be permitted or authorized to use the designation RMT.

(6.4) Associate Membership:

(a) Notwithstanding 6.2 above, the Executive Committee of the Association may admit to Associate membership in the Association persons:

- who are a resident of Saskatchewan; and
- who are music publishers, owners or managers of music stores, music librarians, piano tuners with certificates from approved schools and presidents of music festivals or others as approved by the Executive Committee;

(b) Associate members shall have no voting privileges but they may attend annual and local meetings;

(c) Associate members shall not be permitted or authorized to use the designation RMT.

(6.5) Honorary Life Membership:

(a) Honorary Life Membership may be conferred upon a member for outstanding service to the Association after unanimous consent of the Advisory Board and the Executive Committee.

(6.6) Bylaws:

(a) Amendments to the bylaws may be presented by the Executive Committee, or a special committee under its jurisdiction as the case may be, at an annual meeting or special meeting, as the case may be;

(b) Amendments to the bylaws must be confirmed by a two-thirds majority vote at an annual meeting or special meeting of the Association;

(c) Notification to all members of such bylaw amendments must be given at least 14 days prior to the next annual meeting or a special meeting called for that purpose.

(6.7) Professional Conduct Committee:

(a) The Committee shall consist of a minimum of three association members of good standing that are appointed yearly by the Executive;

(b) These members cannot be members of the Discipline Committee;

(c) If an appointee resigns, the executive will appoint a successor for the remainder of the term.

(6.8) Discipline Committee:

(a) The Discipline Committee shall consist of a minimum of three members; two association members of good standing who are appointed yearly by the Executive and the third member shall be the public appointee;

(b) These members cannot be members of the Professional Conduct Committee;

(c) If an appointee resigns, the executive will appoint a successor for the remainder of that term;

(d) This committee may make rules regulating their business and proceedings.

Coming into Force

These bylaws come into force on the day on which *The Registered Music Teachers' Act, 2002* comes into force.

**EXTRACTS FROM THE RULES AND PROCEDURES
OF THE LEGISLATIVE
ASSEMBLY OF SASKATCHEWAN
RELATING TO PRIVATE BILLS**

PETITIONS

12(1) A petition to the Assembly may be presented by a Member at any time during the sitting of the Assembly by filing the same with the Clerk of the Assembly.

(6) Petitions may be either written or printed, provided always that when there are three or more petitioners, the signatures of at least three petitioners shall be subscribed on the sheet containing the prayer of the petition.

(9) No petition can be received which prays for any expenditure, grant or charge on the public revenue, whether payable out of the Consolidated Fund or out of moneys to be provided by the Assembly.

NOTE: *A form of Petition can be obtained on application to the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly.*

PRIVATE BILLS

64(1) All petitions for Private Bills shall be in duplicate and shall be filed with the Clerk of the Assembly not later than the twentieth sitting day of the Session.

(2) No petition for any Private Bill shall be received by the Assembly if presented after the first twenty-five sitting days of the Session.

(3) No Private Bill may be introduced in the Assembly after the first thirty sitting days of the Session.

65(1) Every applicant for a Private Bill shall deposit with the Clerk of the Assembly along with the petition for same, two copies of the bill, with marginal notes inserted, and an accepted cheque payable to the Minister of Finance for the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, if the said bill does not exceed ten pages, and fifteen dollars additional for each page over that number, four hundred and fifty words shall be held to constitute a page.

(2) In the case of a bill incorporating a company, a receipt from the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies for any statutory fees required shall also be deposited with the Clerk of the Assembly.

66 No remittance of a deposit on account of a Private Bill or any portion thereof shall be ordered by the Assembly unless the same has been recommended by the committee charged with its consideration, or unless the bill has been withdrawn, rejected or not reported upon, in which cases the actual expenses incurred shall be deducted from the deposit received before making such remittance.

68(1) All petitions to the Legislature for Private Bills of any nature whatsoever, shall require a notice, clearly and distinctly specifying the nature and object of the application and where the same refers to any proposed work, indicating generally the location of the work, and signed by and on behalf of the petitioners, with the address of the party signing the same; and when the petition is for an act of incorporation the name of the proposed company shall be stated in the notice.

(2) Such notice shall be published prior to the filing of the petition with the Clerk of the Assembly as required in Rule 64(1) in two consecutive issues of *The Saskatchewan Gazette* and four consecutive issues of a newspaper, published in English and having circulation in the locality affected.

(3) A copy of the notice with a statutory declaration of the several publications of advertisement shall be filed with the Clerk of the Assembly along with the petition and bill.

69(2) Every bill for an act of incorporation, where a form of model bill has been adopted, shall be drawn in accordance with such model bill, copies of which may be obtained from the Clerk of the Assembly. Any provisions contained in any such bill which are not in accord with the model bill shall be inserted between brackets and shall be so printed.

72 When any bill for confirming any agreement is filed with the Clerk of the Assembly a true copy of such agreement must be attached to it.

COMMITTEE RULING

In cases where the proposed bill provides that the property to be used or occupied by the petitioner be exempt from taxation, either in whole or in part, the petitioner must file with the Clerk of the Assembly, along with the petition, a written statement from the local municipal authority in which the said property is situated approving the intent of the provisions of the proposed bill which provide for the exemption from taxation.

The name of the Member who is to present the petition and Private Bill must be furnished to the Clerk of the Assembly at the time of filing the petition. Such Member should not, of course, be a Member of the Cabinet.

12(1) Les députés peuvent toujours présenter les pétitions à l'Assemblée pendant les séances en les déposant auprès du greffier.

(6) Les pétitions sont écrites ou imprimées; s'il y a plus que deux pétitionnaires, au moins trois de ceux-ci inscrivent leur signature sur la feuille qui expose la requête.

(9) Ne sont pas recevables, les pétitions qui demandent que soient faites sur les revenus publics, y compris le Trésor et les sommes allouées par l'Assemblée, des dépenses, des subventions ou des charges.

AVIS — *Un formulaire de pétition est disponible sur demande auprès du greffier de l'Assemblée législative.*

PROJETS DE LOI D'INTÉRÊT PRIVÉ

64(1) Deux exemplaires des pétitions introductives de projets de loi d'intérêt privé sont déposés auprès du greffier dans les vingt jours de séance de l'ouverture de la session.

(2) Seules sont recevables par l'Assemblée, les pétitions introductives de projet de loi d'intérêt privé qui sont présentées dans les vingt-cinq jours de séance de l'ouverture de la session.

(3) Les projets de loi d'intérêt privé ne peuvent être déposés à l'Assemblée que dans les trente jours de séance de l'ouverture de la session.

65(1) Les personnes qui demandent un projet de loi d'intérêt privé déposent auprès du greffier, outre la pétition connexe, deux exemplaires du projet de loi qui portent les notes marginales ainsi qu'un chèque visé payable au ministre des Finances, au montant de deux cent cinquante dollars si le projet de loi est composé d'au plus dix pages; ce montant est majoré de quinze dollars par page supplémentaire. Une page est réputée renfermer quatre cent cinquante mots.

(2) Si le projet de loi prévoit la constitution d'une société, le récépissé des droits réglementaires donné par le registraire des sociétés par action est également déposé auprès du greffier.

66 L'Assemblée ne peut ordonner la remise totale ou partielle des dépôts relatifs aux projets de loi d'intérêt privé, sauf recommandation du comité chargé d'étudier le projet en question ou si celui-ci est retiré ou rejeté ou encore n'est pas rapporté.
