CHAPTER Q-3 REG 2
The Queen's Printer's Act

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Queen's Printer's Fees Regulations, 2004*.

Interpretation

2 In these regulations, "**Act**" means *The Queen's Printer's Act*.

Tariff of charges

3 The Tariff of Charges set out in the Appendix to these regulations for publishing notices, advertisements and documents in the Gazette is prescribed for the purposes of section 7 of the Act.

Designation of persons required to pay charges

4 For the purposes of section 7 of the Act, persons, partnerships or associations on whose behalf a notice mentioned in Column 1 of Part 1 of the Tariff of Charges is required to be published in the Gazette are designated as persons, partnerships or associations who are required to pay the charge set out in Column 2 opposite the notice.

5 The subscription price for the Gazette is \$125 per year.
