

Pool Status Process

The Big Game Draw uses a system of priority pools to give higher priority to those who go longer periods without being drawn.

- Pools are established based on the last time a hunter was drawn for a particular species.
- The increase in applicants over the years has reduced the odds of being drawn for many species.
- The longer someone goes without being drawn, the higher their priority pool will be.
- You can check your status by selecting the **Pool Status** page in the **My Account** section of your Hunting, Angling and Trapping Licence (HAL) account. Pool status will be available for each species you apply for.

Legacy Pool First Priority

1

1. Applicants who were in the Super A pool for the previous 10 consecutive years without having been drawn.
2. Hunters **must apply each year** and maintain their Super A status for each species to be counted toward the Legacy status.
3. Hunters who qualify for Legacy status, but are not drawn, **must continue to apply each year** to maintain their status. Zone 99 applications are accepted.

Super A Pool 2nd Priority

2

1. Applicants who qualified for A pool the previous year but were not drawn, as well as applicants who were in Super A the previous year but were not drawn and do not qualify for the Legacy pool.
2. To advance to Super A status and maintain it, applicants **must continue to apply** for that species every year until drawn. After an applicant has 10 consecutive unsuccessful years in Super A, they will advance to Legacy status.

A Pool 3rd Priority

3

1. Applicants who were in the B pool the previous year and were not drawn, as well as applicants who were in the Super A or Legacy pools the previous year but did not apply.
2. Once applicants reach the A pool, they will not advance to the next highest priority status unless they apply.

B Pool 4th Priority

4

Applicants who were in the C pool the previous year but were not drawn.

C Pool 5th Priority

5

Applicants who were in the D pool the previous year but were not drawn.

D Pool 6th Priority

6

Applicants who were drawn the previous year and all first-time applicants for a species.

If an application is submitted with more than one hunter, the application is placed in the priority pool of the hunter with the lowest pool status.
