Wildfires of Note:

23BN-VERMETTE (Southwest of Dillon)

Current Size: 65,547.0 ha.

Resources: Type 1 Crew Members, Type 2 Crews, Type 3 Crews, Heavy Equipment, Helicopter Support

Communities<20km: Dillon, St. George's Hill, Michel Village

Values in Area: Highway 925

Impacts: Evacuation of Priority 1 and 2 people from Dillon, St. George's Hill, Michel Village

Crews will work to contain all hot spots around the northeast side of the fire towards St. George's Hill using heavy equipment for water support in the dry areas. Crews will also continue to move to the northwest corner of the fire to

construct helicopter pads in order to move crews in to work on the perimeter and suppress all hot spots in the area of concern assisted by helicopter support as needed.

23LX-SHAW (Between Buffalo Narrows and Ile-A-La Crosse)

Current Size: 133,113.0 ha.

Resources: Type 1 Crew Members, Type 2 Crews, Heavy Equipment, Helicopter Support, Air Tanker Support

Communities<20km: Buffalo Narrows, Ile-A-La Crosse

Values in Area: Highway 925, Highway 155, Highway 908, SaskPower Infrastructure

Impacts: Evacuation of Priority 1 and 2 people from Buffalo Narrows, Ile-A-La Crosse, Patuanak

Crews continue suppression efforts near Highways 908, 155 and 925. Crews are also concentrating efforts by powerlines around the Niska Channel. Values protection units will continue to be serviced as needed.

23LA-WISTIGO (Southeast of Pinehouse Lake)

Current Size: 62,766.0 ha.

Resources: Type 1 Crew members, Type 2 Crews, Type 3 Crews, Heavy Equipment, Helicopter Support Values in area: Highway 165, Highway 910, Besnard Correctional Camp, Besnard Lake Lodge, Commercial

Timber.

Impacts: Besnard Correctional Camp evacuation

Values protection work continues the southeast corner of Pinehouse Lake, and values protection units are being redeployed as needed. Dozer line construction continues along Highway 910 and crews continue suppression efforts on the northwest, and south sides of the fire around Highway 165.

23LA-SHARP (North of La Ronge)

Current Size: 17,965.0 ha.

Resources: Type 1 Crew Members, Type 2 Crews, Helicopter Support, Air Tanker Support

Communities<20km: Sucker River, Northern Admin District of Wadin Bay

Values in Area: Highway 102, Sucker River Cultural Camp, McKay Lake Recreation site, Wadin Bay

Recreation site.

Impacts: McKay Lake and Wadin Bay campgrounds are closed.

Values protection work to occur in the north end of Nemebien Lake. Crews will continue working to extinguish hot spots, and to establish helicopter pads on the south side of the fire.

23DB-KPIR02 (South of Deschambault Lake)

Current Size: 4,605.4 ha.

Resources: Type 1 Crew Members, Type 2 Crews, Type 3 Crews, Helicopter Support, Air Tanker Support

Communities<20km: Deschambault Lake

Values in Area: Highway 911

Impacts: Highway 911 intermittent closure, Deschambault Lake evacuation.
