Wildfires of Note:

23SR-TODOS (West of Fond Du Lac)

Report Date: July 22, 2023
Current Size: 2,540 ha.
Status: Not Contained
Resources: Type 1 Crew Members, Type 2 Crews, Helicopter Support, Air Tanker Support
Communities<20km: Fond Du Lac
Values in Area: Highway 968
Impacts: Evacuation of Priority 1 community members from Fond Du Lac.
Weather: Winds west 10 to 15 km/h, gusting 30 km/h. Mostly sunny skies in the region

with a lake breeze that may develop, increasing and shifting winds along the lake. Max temperature of 25C with minimum relative humidity of 30%. No precipitation forecast.

A crew will work on the northwest flank moving eastward. An assessment on the north flank of the fire will be completed and crews will assess the requirement for further helicopter pads. Air tanker support will be used to prevent the fire from jumping the Grease River to the north.
