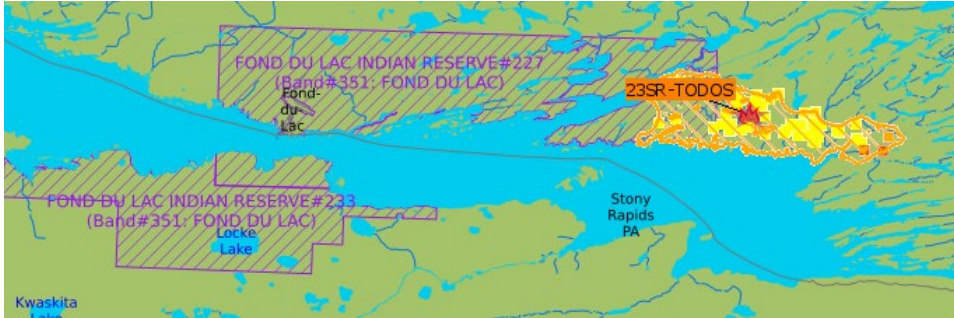
Wildfires of Note:

23SR-TODOS (East of Fond Du Lac)

Report Date: July 22, 2023
Current Size: 2,685.4 ha.
Status: Not Contained
Resources: Type 1 Crew Members, Type 2 Crews, Helicopter Support, Air Tanker Support
Communities<20km: Fond Du Lac
Values in Area: Highway 968
Impacts: Evacuation of Priority 1 community members from Fond Du Lac.

Weather: Winds south/southwest 5 to 10 km/h, gusting to 20 km/h and then winds west/northwest 10 to 15 km/h, gusting to 25 km/h; light and variable at times. Mostly cloudy skies with scattered showers and a chance of thundershower in the area. Maximum temperature of 22 C with minimum relative humidity: 60%. Less than 2 mm of showers with up to 15 mm and winds gusting to 70 km/h in thundershowers. A chance of small hail is possible in the thundershowers.

Crews will continue working on hotspots and running a line in the north and northwest flanks. Helicopters will be assisting with bucket support. Received 5 mm of precipitation overnight.



23SR-HAMIL (West of Wollaston Lake)

Report Date: July 26, 2023
Current Size: 4,800 ha.
Status: Not Contained
Resources: Type 1 Crew Members, Type 2 Crews, Helicopter Support, Air Tanker Support
Values in Area: Highway 905, SaskPower Infrastructure, SaskTel Infrastructure, Airstrip
Impacts: Manned barricades along Highway 905.

Weather: Winds under the low pressure system are light and variable; east of the low are southwest 10 to 20 km/h, gusting to 30 km/h; south of the low are west 20 to 30 km/h, gusting to 50 km/h; and west of the low are north/northwest 20 to 30 km/h, gusting to 40 km/h. Mostly cloudy skies with a chance of showers or thundershowers in the region. Maximum temperature of 22 C with minimum relative humidity: 55%. 2 to 5 mm of showers with up to 15 mm and winds gusting to 70 km/h in thundershowers. A chance of small hail is possible in the thundershowers.

Crews will work on the southeast and southwest flanks putting in pads and running a hose line towards Highway 905 and east of the highway. Helicopters will be assisting with bucket support. Received 4.8 mm of precipitation overnight.
