

Saskatchewan Employment Incentive (SEI)

What is the Saskatchewan Employment Incentive (SEI)?

The SEI provides working families who have lower incomes with a monthly financial benefit.

What other supports are available through this program?

The SEI also offers nominations for Supplementary Health Benefits, access to discount bus passes (where available), connections to employment supports through the Ministry of Immigration and Career Training and access to the Saskatchewan Housing Benefit through the Saskatchewan Housing Corporation.

Who is eligible for SEI?

You may be eligible if the following apply to you:

- You are a Canadian Citizen or permanent resident;
- You are living in Saskatchewan;
- You are 18 years or older; You have a valid Social Insurance Number and Saskatchewan Health Services Number;
- You have children ages 0-12, and/or children ages 13-17 who require childcare due to special circumstances, and receive the Canada Child Benefit or are a Person of Sufficient Interest for those children;
- You have a minimum of \$500 per month from employment and/or self-employment (before deductions); and,
- You do not receive Saskatchewan Income Support or Saskatchewan Assured Income for Disability benefits. If you are receiving the Saskatchewan Employment Supplement and/or Child Care Subsidy your involvement in those programs will need to end to be able to receive the SEI.

The following table outlines the maximum financial benefit available to your family:

Maximum Monthly SEI Financial Benefit

ELIGIBLE CHILDREN	BENEFIT
1	\$400
2	\$500
3+	\$600

How is the monthly financial benefit amount determined?

The maximum financial benefit available to you is based on your family income and the number of eligible children you have.

You will receive the maximum SEI benefit when your family income falls between \$500 and \$2,200 per month.

How do families apply for SEI?

Applications are completed online through your Saskatchewan.ca account. Clients can also access application forms, report changes in their circumstances and submit additional documents or report their income at any time of the day.
