Childhood Immunization Schedule	
Age/Grade	Vaccine Abbreviations and Complete Names
2 months	DTaP-IPV-Hib (Diphtheria, Tetanus, acellular Pertussis, inactivated Polio & <i>Haemophilus influenzae</i> type b) Pneu-C-15 (Pneumococcal conjugate 15) Rot-5 (Rotavirus)
4 months	DTaP-IPV-Hib (Diphtheria, Tetanus, acellular Pertussis, inactivated Polio & <i>Haemophilus influenzae</i> type b) Pneu-C-15 (Pneumococcal conjugate 15) Rot-5 (Rotavirus)
6 months	DTaP-IPV-Hib (Diphtheria, Tetanus, acellular Pertussis, inactivated Polio & <i>Haemophilus influenzae</i> type b) Rot-5 (Rotavirus)
12 months	MMRV (Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Varicella) Men-C-C (Meningococcal conjugate C) Pneu-C-15 (Pneumococcal conjugate 15)
18 months	DTaP-IPV-Hib (Diphtheria, Tetanus, acellular Pertussis, inactivated Polio & <i>Haemophilus influenzae</i> type b) MMRV (Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Varicella)
4-6 years	Tdap-IPV (Tetanus, Diphtheria, acellular Pertussis, inactivated Polio)
Grade 6	HB (Hepatitis B) HPV-9 (Human papillomavirus – 9 strains)
Grade 8	Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, acellular Pertussis)
6 months - 17 years	Influenza (yearly)
Adult Immunization Schedule	
18 years & older	Influenza (yearly) Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, acellular Pertussis) every 10 years and in every pregnancy MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella for those born since January 1, 1971) IPV (inactivated Polio for eligible adults) Varicella (for eligible adults)
65 years & older	Influenza vaccine (high dose) (yearly) Pneu-C-20 (Pneumococcal conjugate 20) for seniors who have never received any previous pneumococcal vaccines.
Individuals with Select Risk Factors	
Check with a Public Health Nurse or your healthcare provider if you are eligible to receive these vaccines.	Hepatitis A Hepatitis B Haemophilus influenzae type b Small pox - Mpox Meningococcal B Meningococcal conjugate ACYW-135 Pneumococcal conjugate 20
