

## **NOTICE TO BUSINESSES IMPACTED BY NORTHERN FIRES**

Tax clients directly impacted by the province's fire activity that are unable to file and/or pay their provincial tax return(s) by the due date may submit a [Penalty and Interest Waiver Application](#) for relief from penalty and interest charges on the return(s) affected. The application should include details of the fire-related circumstances that prevented the return(s) from being filed and/or paid on time and the location of your business. The form can be submitted by email to [sasktaxinfo@gov.sk.ca](mailto:sasktaxinfo@gov.sk.ca).

The easiest and quickest way to file your provincial tax return(s) is electronically through the Saskatchewan eTax Services (SETS) at [sets.saskatchewan.ca](https://sets.saskatchewan.ca) or through online business services offered by your financial institution (e.g., Telpay or CanAct).

Electronic payment(s) can be made online using SETS (Electronic Funds Transfer), through your personal or business online banking services, or through wire transfer.

### **REFUNDS AND PAYMENTS**

If you are expecting a refund or payment and are not set up with direct deposit, you can contact our office at 1-800-667-6102 to establish a direct deposit or to provide an alternate mailing address in the event of relocation. Refunds can also be sent by courier at the recipient's expense.
