



**ORDER for Increasing Weight Designation on Provincial Highways**

Pursuant to clause 35.1(1)(d) of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, the Minister hereby Orders:

1. Any person, vehicle or class of vehicles is hereby authorized to operate at the weights set for secondary highways pursuant to *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations, 2010*, on:
  - a. Provincial Highway No. 339 from the rural municipal road at northwest corner of land location Section 8, Township 13, Range 24, West of the Second Meridian to the junction with Provincial Highway No. 39.
2. Provincial Highway No. 339 from the junction of Provincial Highway No. 39 to 15 kilometres south shall remain secondary weight and Appendix D clause (kk) of *The Vehicle Weights and Dimension Regulations, 2010* does not apply under this Order.
3. Provincial Highway No. 334 from the junction with Provincial Highway No. 13 to 3.3 kilometres south of the intersection of Provincial Highway No. 334 and Provincial Highway No. 339 in the vicinity of the Village of Avonlea, shall remain restricted to 8 tonnes as directed in the Minister's Order 334 and 339-2017-WR1, issued on January 11, 2017.
4. Provincial Highway No. 339 from the junction with Provincial Highway 334 to the municipal road located at the northeast corner of land location Section 35, Township 12, Range 24, West of the Second Meridian, shall remain restricted to 8 tonnes as directed in the Minister's Order 334 and 339-2017-WR1, issued on January 11, 2017.
