

Acquired Brain Injury (ABI) Partnership Outreach Teams & Regional Coordinators

What is the Acquired Brain Injury (ABI) Partnership?

The ABI Partnership provides a range of community-based services for individuals with ABI and their family. Services are funded by SGI and provided by The Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) and various community-based organizations (CBOs).

Clients, families and caregivers can receive education, rehabilitation, life enrichment and residential and vocational services as close to their home communities as possible.

Outreach Teams & Regional Coordinators

Who are the Outreach Teams & Regional Coordinators?

The outreach teams consist of rehabilitation specialists in ABI. Services are provided through the SHA and are in Prince Albert (North), Saskatoon (Central), and Regina (South). Each provide service to the broader geographical area around these centres.

Who Can Qualify for Services?

To qualify for outreach services, an individual must:

- have a diagnosis of a moderate to severe ABI supported by medical records and be medically stable.
- be a resident of Saskatchewan or eligible for coverage, and;
- be open to working cooperatively on goal directed rehabilitation.

Families, caregivers, community agencies, and schools who require resources, education, and support are also eligible.

Priority is given to those injured in the past 3 years. Individuals with a congenital brain injury or one resulting from a progressive condition are not eligible for services under this program.

How do I Connect with the Outreach Teams?

Self-referrals and those from health facilities, physicians, rehabilitation and professional support services, schools, and community agencies are accepted. For more information, please contact:
