

# Acquired Brain Injury (ABI) Partnership Education & Prevention Services

## Who are We?

The ABI Education and Prevention (E&P) Program is part of a comprehensive strategy managed by the Saskatchewan Ministry of Health and funded by SGI.

Injury prevention programs are funded across the province to help prevent brain injuries from occurring in Saskatchewan each year. These programs help reduce injury rates and promote safe lifestyle choices.

The Partnership Program funds three health educators within the province to assist communities to develop, coordinate, facilitate, and evaluate education and injury prevention initiatives.

## How can we Help?

The E&P coordinators can provide specific programming, such as Brain Walk, or help to provide ongoing support to programming developed within a community. Topics include:

- Brain Function/Structure/Health & Wellness
- Helmet Usage
- Safe Road Usage

- Off-Road Vehicle Safety
- Child Passenger Safety
- Falls Prevention
- Sports & Recreation Safety

## Community Grant Funding

The Community Grant Program is jointly run with the ABI Partnership and SGI. The goal of the grants is to help communities establish, enhance, and deliver programs that address safety issues. SGI and the ABI program provide support and guidance in identifying priorities for programming and can help with development and implementation of new or existing programs.
