## CHAPTER M-23.2 REG 2

### *The Municipal Board Act*

#### **Title**

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Municipal Board Transition Regulations, 1989*.

#### **Saskatchewan Municipal Board may complete, etc., certain matters**

2(1) Subject to subsection (2), the Saskatchewan Municipal Board may take up, conduct and continue to their completion any matters with respect to which the Municipal Boundary Commission established pursuant to *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984* had, prior to October 1, 1988:

(a) jurisdiction and with respect to which no action had been taken by the Municipal Boundary Commission prior to that date; and

(b) taken action but had not completed the matters prior to that date, including, but not limited to the application for the alteration of boundaries launched pursuant to *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984*, namely:

Town of Nipawin application to annex lands from the Rural Municipality of Nipawin No. 487 approved by Order in Council 552/88;

as if the matters had been before the Saskatchewan Municipal Board from their commencement.

(2) Any matter with respect to which the Municipal Boundary Commission had taken action prior to October 1, 1988 shall be heard and decided only by members of the Saskatchewan Municipal Board who were previously members of the Municipal Boundary Commission who had sat and heard the matters.

#### **Decisions, etc., of Municipal Boundary Commission remain in force**

4 Subject to any right of appeal and to any other Act or law, every decision, approval, rejection, recommendation, fee, term and condition or other requirement of the Municipal Boundary Commission that existed on the day before the day on which *The Municipal Board Act* came into force remains in effect until repealed, amended or superceded pursuant to the *Municipal Board Act* or these regulations.
