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CHAPTER F-19 REG 13

The Forest Act and *The Provincial Lands Act*

Title

1 These regulations may be cited as *The Rabbit Lake Surface Lease Regulations, 1989*.

Agreement re surface lease

2 The Minister of Parks, Recreation and Culture and the Minister of Economic Development and Tourism are hereby authorized:

(a) to enter into an agreement granting surface rights to Cameco – A Canadian Mining & Energy Corporation substantially in accordance with the provisions set out in the form of the agreement contained in the Appendix; and

(b) to enter into and execute an agreement with Cameco – A Canadian Mining & Energy Corporation substantially in the form of the agreement contained in the Appendix.
