IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the boundaries of Division 3 and Division 7 be altered to reflect the alteration of boundaries in the Rural Municipality of Rosthem No. 403 as herein described. The area within Division 3 and Division 7 shall be described as follows:

the Hudson Bay Company's Reserve; and  
Township 44, Range 5, that portion of Sections 13, 14, 23, 24, and 25 lying to the Right bank  
of Dyck's Creek and that portion lying to the right of the left bank of the North Saskatchewan  
River.

Division 7: All that area within the boundaries of the Organized Hamlet of Neuanlage.

All west of the Third Meridian in the Province of Saskatchewan.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

- 1 The effective date of the boundary alteration for Division 3 and Division 7 is November 4, 2009.
- 2 An election for a councillor to represent each of Division 3 and Division 7 as described herein will be held on November 4, 2009.
- 3 The term of office for the councillor for Division 3 and Division 7 shall expire at the time of the annual election in 2010.
- 4 James Spriggs shall be appointed as Returning Officer and shall conduct the election in conjunction with the annual election to be held for Divisions 2, 4 and 6 on November 4, 2009.

#### DISSOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF ALSASK

- 1 Pursuant to section 53 of *The Municipalities Act*, the Village of Alsask has applied to dissolve into the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292.
- 2 It is deemed appropriate and in the public interest to dissolve the Village of Alsask at this time. The undersigned, therefore issues an Order pursuant to section 61 of *The Municipalities Act* to:
  - (a) dissolve the Village of Alsask and include its area within the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292;
  - (b) designate this area as a "special service area" for the purpose of assigning different tax rates, applying different tax tools and providing different service levels within the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292;
  - (c) confirm the designated "special service area" as being within the boundaries of the former Village of Alsask.
  - (d) create a new division and name the area within the boundaries of the former Village of Alsask as Division 7 in the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292. Accordingly:
    - (i) appoint Peter Winter, of Alsask, as an interim councillor to represent the new Division 7 of the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292, from the effective date of this Order until an election can be held on Wednesday, November 4, 2009;

- (ii) appoint Shelley Mohr, as returning officer, to conduct the election in conjunction with the annual election to be held for Division 2, 4 and 6 on November 4, 2009;
- (iii) the term of office for the councillor representing Division 7 shall expire at the time of the annual election, 2010;
- (e) confirm the terms and conditions of the restructuring agreement entered into by the Village of Alsask and the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292 as follows:
- (i) this agreement has been entered into by the Village of Alsask and the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292 for the purpose of the dissolution of the Village of Alsask;
- (ii) a municipal council consisting of a Reeve and seven councillors will govern the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292, with the Village of Alsask being designated a special service area for the purposes of assigning different tax rates and/or application of tax tools and providing different service levels;
- (iii) the designated service area being within the boundaries of the former Village of Alsask;
- (iv) this agreement may be amended by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292 only when an amendment is in the best interests of the ratepayers of the former Village of Alsask and the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292;
- (v) the assets and liabilities of the Village of Alsask shall become the assets and liabilities of the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292 upon dissolution of the Village of Alsask;
- (vi) cash assets remaining subsequent to settlement of the Village of Alsask's assets and liabilities will be set aside for provision of services and/or benefits within the former Village of Alsask;
- (vii) all grants received by the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292 in recognition of the former Village of Alsask will be set aside for provision of services and/or benefits within the former Village of Alsask;
- (viii) the Rural Municipality may impose special levies for the following purposes if required:
- renewing municipal infrastructure
  - remedying and reclaiming contaminated sites
  - settling any liabilities of the parties
- (ix) the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292 will ensure that fire protection services are inclusive and consistent with fire protection service agreements currently established by the municipality;
- (x) the administrator for the Village of Alsask, Charlotte Helfrick, will not continue as an employee of the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292;
- (xi) the special service area will pay a separate percentage for administration, as set by the Rural Municipality of Antelope Park No. 322, Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292 and the Village of Marengo joint administration board to share the cost of office salaries and expenses;
- (xii) this agreement will come into effect on the date of dissolution as set out in the Minister's Order;
- (xiii) upon dissolution, Alsask shall be considered a separate division within the boundaries of the Rural Municipality of Milton No. 292 and as such, a councillor shall be elected to represent that division;
- (f) confirm that the dissolution shall take effect on July 30, 2009;
- (g) authorize the imposition of special levies on affected properties for a period not greater than 10 years or in the case of retiring a debt of the municipality not greater than the term of the debt, for the following purposes:
- renewing municipal infrastructure;
  - remedying and reclaiming contaminated sites;
  - settling any liabilities;

(h) appoint Shelley Mohr to adjust and settle the assets and liabilities of the Village of Alsask including:

- (i) the sale of, the disposition of and the conversion into money of sufficient assets to satisfy the liabilities of the village and pay the remuneration of the person appointed by this Order;
- (ii) the allocation of any grants, surplus funds and reserves; and
- (iii) the manner of dealing with the liabilities and pursuant to section 63(4) of *The Municipalities Act*, if there are insufficient realizable assets to satisfy the liabilities of the municipality to: assess, levy, collect and enforce payment of any amount that may be required to satisfy the liabilities of the municipality and all associated expenses and pay the remuneration of the person appointed pursuant to this Order;

(i) determine the remuneration payable to Shelley Mohr to be \$32.00 per hour of work, and \$0.3888 per travelled kilometre and reimbursement of related miscellaneous expenses.
