

Pesticide Applicator Licence Application Form

Please read instructions before completing this application form. All sections of the form must be completed before a licence can be issued. Please print legibly. If all sections are not completed, the form will be returned to you.

Note: This form may also be used by licensed applicators to obtain additional licence categories. If the application form is being used for this purpose, no payment is required. Contact the Saskatchewan Ministry of Agriculture at 306-787-4662 for any questions relating to completion of this form. A licence will be mailed in 15 business days pending receipt of proper documentation.

Instructions

- Name:** The name of the person who will be applying pesticides as a service for hire or reward.
- Mailing Address:** The address of the person applying for the licence.
- Telephone Numbers:** Please include both business and home phone numbers, as well as the area code.
 - Birth Date:** Indicate the day, month and year.
 - Rural Municipality:** Number of the Rural Municipality where you reside.
- Business Name and Pesticide Service Licence Number:** Business/employer name and service licence number for whom you apply pesticides.
- Pesticide Applicator Training Courses:** List the pesticide applicator training course(s) you have completed in the past four years (attach a photocopy of certificate of training). An approved training course must be completed before applying for a licence. For out-of-province applicators, see the Out-Of-Province Pesticide Applicator Requirements webpage by visiting saskatchewan.ca and searching "pesticide applicator licence".
- Category of Pesticide Applicator Licences:** Saskatchewan pesticide applicator licences are divided into categories as indicated in the list below. For each category of licence you are applying for, please indicate:
 - The licence category (see list below).
 - The other provinces or states for which you hold a valid permit or licence to apply pesticides (for the equivalent type of pest control), indicate the permit/licence number and attach photocopies. Use the abbreviation as follows:

BC - British Columbia	QC - Quebec	PE - Prince Edward Island
AB - Alberta	NS - Nova Scotia	NT - Northwest Territories
MB - Manitoba	NB - New Brunswick	YT - Yukon
ON - Ontario	NL - Newfoundland	

For the United States, use standard state abbreviations as listed in telephone directory.

- If applying for an Aerial licence, indicate your Commercial Pilot Licence Number
- Spray Equipment:** Indicate the type, model, capacity and year of the equipment you will be using to apply pesticides, if applicable (i.e. Cessna Ag Wagon, Easy Rider or Backpack Sprayers).
 - Confidentiality of Your File:** The details of your licence may be released under The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act. The Ministry of Agriculture may be asked by non-government agencies, firms or individuals to provide lists of licensed pesticide applicators. If you would like your name and address released, please check the "YES" box. If not, check "NO".
 - Date and Signature:** Page 2 of the form must be signed and dated by the person requesting the licence. Once you have completed all sections on this form, forward page 2 together with a photocopy of approved training, out-of-province licences and the licence fee of \$100, to:

Categories of Pesticide Applicator Licences

- Aerial:** authorizes the use of pesticides applied by aircraft. This includes forested lands and woodlands, to control industrial vegetation, on ornamentals, for mosquito and biting fly control over land and water, and on agricultural lands.
- Agriculture:** authorizes the use of pesticides by ground application for the production of livestock and agricultural crops.
- Aquatic:** authorizes the use of herbicides by ground application for the control of aquatic weeds in temporary or permanent water bodies.
- Forestry:** authorizes the use of pesticides by ground application in forest management operations and/or silviculture, forest seed orchards, outdoor nurseries and plantations.
- Fumigation:** authorizes the use of all fumigants within enclosed structures or the use of fumigant gases under sheets/tarps.
- Greenhouse:** authorizes the use of pesticides in greenhouses and mushroom houses during the storage, display and/or production of agricultural crops including vegetables, ornamentals and mushrooms, as well as forest tree seedlings.
- Industrial Vegetation:** authorizes the use of herbicides by ground application for controlling weeds on industrial areas including roadsides, power lines, pipelines, rights-of-way, easements, railways, petroleum well sites and equipment yards.
- Landscape:** authorizes the use of pesticides (other than fumigants) by ground application for the maintenance of ornamental trees, shrubs, flowers and turf on outdoor residential, commercial (e.g. golf courses, and cemeteries), recreational and public land.
- Mosquito and Biting Fly:** authorizes the use of insecticides into water or on land, by ground application only, for the control of mosquitoes and other biting flies.
- Structural:** authorizes the use of pesticides for the prevention or control of pests that impact a structure or its inhabitants.
- Special:** authorizes activities to be specified in the licence:
 - Commercial Seed Treatment:** authorizes the application of pesticides for commercial seed treatment.
 - On-Farm Fumigation:** authorizes the limited use of fumigants for the control of insects in stored grain and for field control of rodents (on farm use only).
 - Problem Wildlife Control:** for Government of Saskatchewan employees only.
 - Rat Control:** authorizes the use of rodenticides in or around buildings or structures for the control of mice and rats.
 - Parks Management:** for employees of Federal, Provincial and Regional Parks only.
