CHAPTER 118

An Act to incorporate The Saskatoon Mortgage Company, Limited

(Assented to April 4, 1946)

Preamble

WHEREAS the person hereinafter named have by their petition prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Incorporation

1 Thomas Harvey Newell, Agent, Herman Wesley Hildred, Agent, Robert Percy Klombies, Agent, Frederick Finlay MacDermid, Barrister-at-Law, and Annastasia Korda, Stenographer, all of the City of Saskatoon in the Province of Saskatchewan, together with such other persons as become shareholders in the company, are incorporated under the name of "The Saskatoon Mortgage Company Limited", hereinafter called "the company".

Provisional directors

2 The persons named in section 1 of this Act shall be the provisional directors of the company.

Capital stock

3 The capital stock of the company shall be two hundred and fifty thousand dollars.

Head office

4 The head office of the company shall be in the City of Saskatoon in the Province of Saskatchewan.

Powers

5 The company shall have all the powers, privileges and immunities conferred by and be subject to all the limitations, liabilities and provisions of *The Loan Companies Act*.
